A RESOLUTION OF ENUMCLAW FIRE DEPARTMENT AUTHORIZING THE ENTRY INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH PUGET SOUND REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY FOR FIRE APPARATUS SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Fire Apparatus Service Agreement is to provide the necessary maintenance and repair of fire apparatus equipment owned and operated by Enumclaw Fire in order to maintain quality emergency services.

WHEREAS, Puget Sound Fire currently has the facilities and personnel to perform this necessary service and is willing to extend this service to Enumclaw Fire.

WHEREAS, it is recognized that fire and emergency apparatus are unique vehicles that require special attention. This type of service and repair can better be performed by personnel that only repair emergency apparatus, and this same service cannot be provided by the local customary repair shop or garage.


WHEREAS, this Agreement is made and entered into pursuant to the provisions of RCW Chapter 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperation Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Enumclaw Fire Department do hereby resolve as follows:


Section 1: That the Fire Chief is authorized to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Puget Sound Regional Fire Authority attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit "1".


Section 2: If any provision of this Resolution and/or the attached Agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions of this Resolution and/or the attached Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.




