Department of Natural Resources Radio System Sharing Agreement

This agreement is made between the Washington State Department of Natural Resources (hereafter "DNR") and the eligible public safety organization (hereafter "Cooperator")

WHEREAS, DNR is licensed by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to use certain radio frequencies in the Public Safety Pool (47 CFR 90.15) and is authorized to share Radio Stations under the provisions of the FCC Rules §90.179.

WHEREAS, DNR is the public safety agency with primary responsibility for wildland firefighting within the State of Washington and is a significant participant in other emergency events.

WHEREAS, the sharing of DNR radio systems is an essential component of interagency cooperation and interoperability during wildfire suppression and other emergency events.

THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED:

1. DNR shall share radio system components and channels with Enumclaw Fire Department to facilitate public safety and mutual aid during wildfire and other emergency events. Shared use is intended for interagency public safety communications and, unless otherwise provided for, is not intended for routine operations or to otherwise supplant the Cooperator's radio system.
2. Shared radio system components are as defined in the "Public Safety Cooperator Frequency Guide," which DNR shall publish annually, and which by this reference is made a part hereof. Cooperator shall ensure its field and technical staff are provided with the most current version.
3. The Method of Operation and radio procedures shall be as defined herein and as defined in the "Public Safety Cooperator Frequency Guide."
4. DNR shall share radio system components and channels with Cooperator at no cost. Enumclaw Fire Department shall be responsible for all costs required to configure, maintain, and repair Enumclaw Fire Department's radio equipment.
5. Enumclaw Fire Department acknowledges that all shared transmitter use shall be subject to the licensee's control as required by FCC Rule §90.179.
6. Enumclaw Fire Department shall, "Exercise discretion and control to ensure that radios are used only for the permitted purpose, only in the permissible manner, and only by persons with authority to use and operate the equipment," as required by FCC Rules §90.403 (a).

7. All radio transmissions shall include the sending unit identification and the radio station call-sign indicated in Public Safety Cooperator Frequency Guide as required by FCC Rule §90.425.
8. **Enumclaw Fire Department**, by transmitting on the **DNR** radio system frequencies, agree to these conditions and affirm that they are eligible under §90.179.
9. This agreement may be terminated by **Enumclaw Fire Department** by providing written notice to **Enumclaw Fire Department's** authorized representative; such termination shall be effective upon receipt.
