Dear County Councilmembers,

My name is Mark L. Thompson, President of the King County Fire Commissioners Association, representing the elected officials of King County Fire Districts and Regional Fire Authorities.

I am writing you today in support of Proposed Ordinance 2020-0109, Fireworks Ban in Unincorporated King County.

Each year numerous debilitating injuries, serious burns and deaths as well as the destruction and/or damage to property, buildings and wildlands occurs due to non-professional use of fireworks.

As a precaution based on historical data local fire districts and fire departments staff up with extra Aid Cars and Engine Companies on the New Years and 4th of July holidays in an effort to respond exclusively to 911 calls for service due to non-professional fireworks use. These additional staffing costs is a serious financial impact to the limited fiscal resources that fire districts have available.

Annually fireworks related responses increase in numbers and severity with legal and non-legal fireworks.

The King County Fire Commissioners Association support and endorse Councilmember McDermott and Council Chair Balducci's proposed fireworks ban ordinance 2020-0109 for Unincorporated King County.

The Fire Commissioners Association would like to suggest the following amendments to the proposed ordinance in an effort to make the ordinance all-encompassing to deter injuries, death and property damage and destruction as well as environmental damage due to the use of fireworks:

1. Addition of language that would raise the penalty for repeat violations. Every time a violator is cited for the illegal possession and/or use of fireworks, after the first violation, the monetary fine would double for every violation thereafter. Numerous state and local ordinance violations have an escalator clause for repeat violations. This would deter and reduce repeat ordinance violations.
2. Add language to address creating a penalty for fireworks possession/use that results in injury and/or death and the destruction or damage to property and buildings and the wildland environment. The penalty should be increased from a misdemeanor to a gross misdemeanor and repeat violations would be charged with reckless endangerment.

The King Co Fire Commissioners Association supports and encourages the authorization of fireworks possession and use by Licensed Pyro Technicians through the Washington State Fire Marshal Office and

when a licensed pyro technician has a valid fireworks display permit issued by the King County Fire Marshal.

During the Council Committee of the Whole, we urge the council to adopt the amendments proposed and vote yes to move the proposed ordinance 2020-0109 to full council with a Do Pass recommendation.

The King County Fire Commissioners Association encourages you to vote, Yes, for the final passage of proposed ordinance 2020-0109 as amended so as to prevent fireworks related injuries, death and destruction or damage to property and the environment starting in December 2021 and January 2022. This ordinance will greatly enhance public safety within the unincorporated areas of King County and provides clear public policy and guidance for enforcement with meaningful consequences to protect lives and property.

RESOLUTION #2020-04**

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Fire Commissioners of Enumclaw Fire Department (aka KCFD #28), King County, Washington, encouraging the King County Council to amend Proposed Ordinance 2020-0109 as suggested by the King County Fire Commissioners Association and to Support the County Council adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2020-0109 as amended

WHEREAS, The King County Council committee meeting of whole has before it a Proposed Ordinance 2020-0109 Unincorporated King County Fireworks Ban, and

WHEREAS, The King County Fire Commissioners Association, a body of Elected Fire Officials from local fire districts and Regional Fire Authorities (RFA's) has submitted two proposed amendments to strengthen the enforcement of the proposed Fireworks Ban Ordinance 2020-0109, and

WHEREAS, citizens of all ages suffer debilitating injuries or loss of life during the use of fireworks and damage and destruction to property results from use and modification of fireworks that are basically an illegal Improvised Explosive Device (IED), and

WHEREAS, local fire departments, at great added expense to taxpayers, have to staff additional fire engines and aid cars to respond to the increasing numbers of injured citizens and wildland/brush and structural fires for which local taxpayers have to shoulder the sole financial burden during the New Years and July 4th holidays,

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Enumclaw Fire Department that the King County Council Committee of the Whole amend Proposed Ordinance 2020-0109 Unincorporated King County Fireworks Ban so as to provide,

a. That the misdemeanor penalty for repeated violation of the possession and/or use of fireworks in the Fireworks Ban Ordinance be doubled for each subsequent violation of the fireworks ban ordinance after the first violation.

b. That the proposed fireworks ban ordinance include a Gross Misdemeanor penalty for the possession and/or use of fireworks that cause injury or death of a person(s) and/or damage or destruction of property. Subsequent violations after a second repeat violation shall be a Reckless Endangerment charge. And

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the King County Council Committee of the Whole, approve Proposed Ordinance 2020-0109 Unincorporated King County Fireworks Ban as amended be forwarded to the full council with a do pass recommendation and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Fire Commissioners of Enumclaw Fire Department support the Public and/or Private Fireworks Displays by licensed Pyrotechnicians by the Washington State Fire Marshal and under site specific permits by the King County Fire Marshal and shall be exempt from the proposed Fireworks Ban Ordinance.
