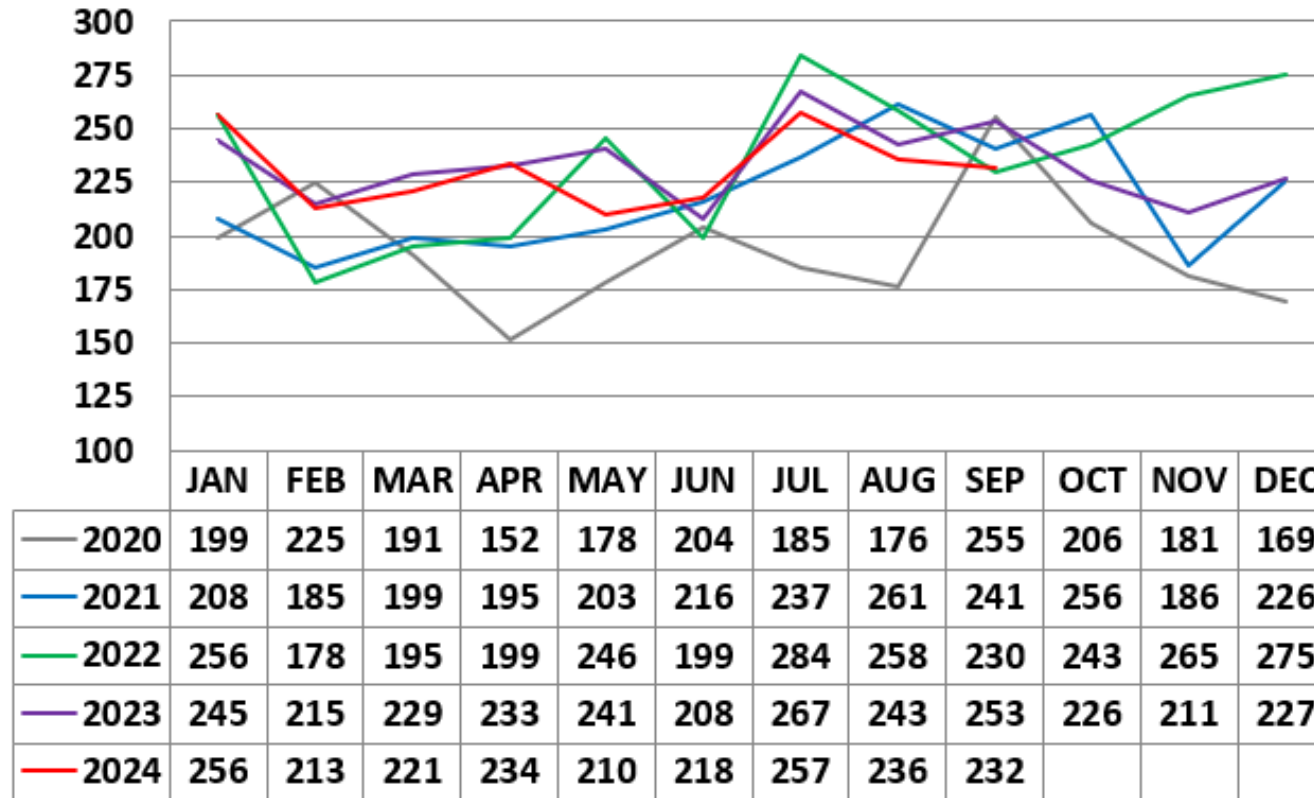

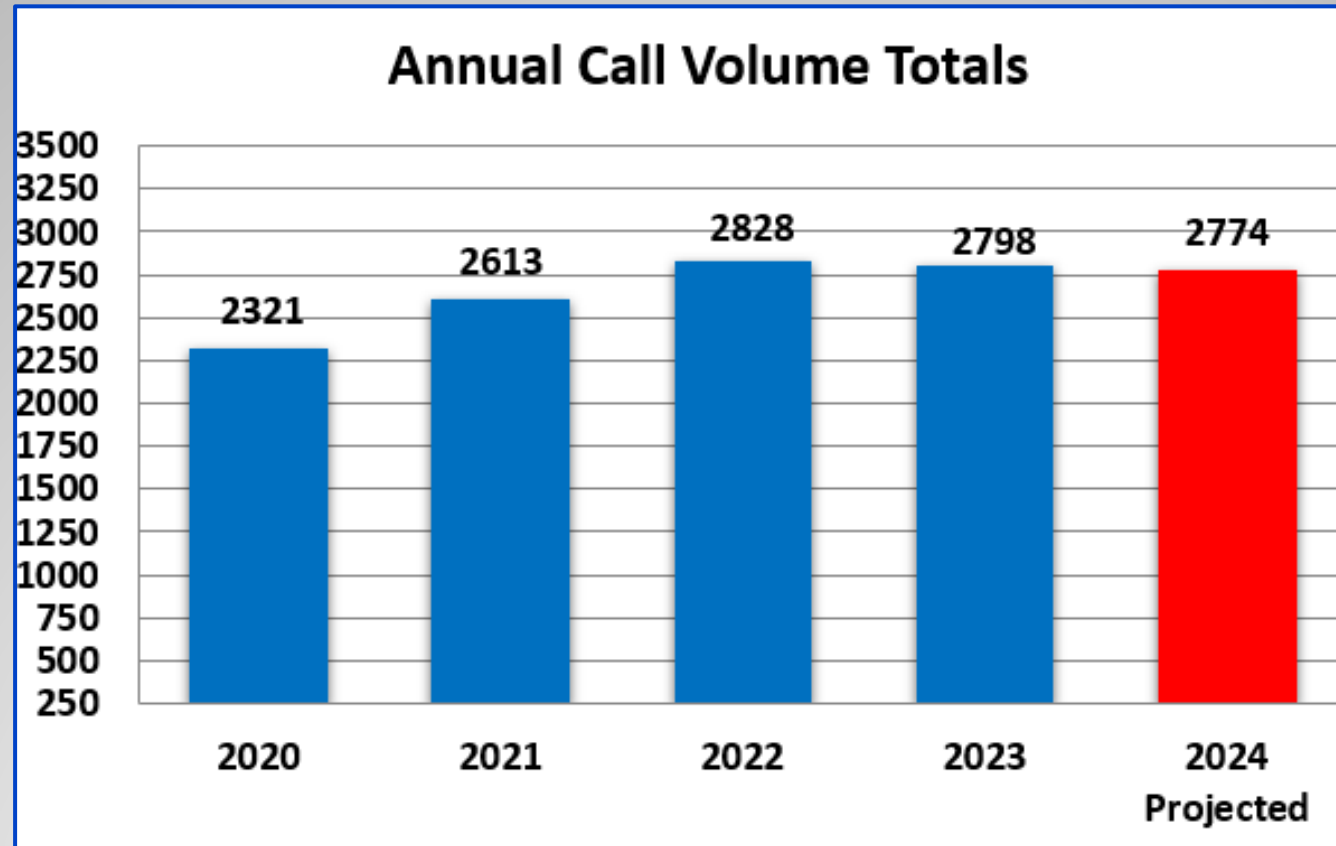

Monthly Call Volume Comparison

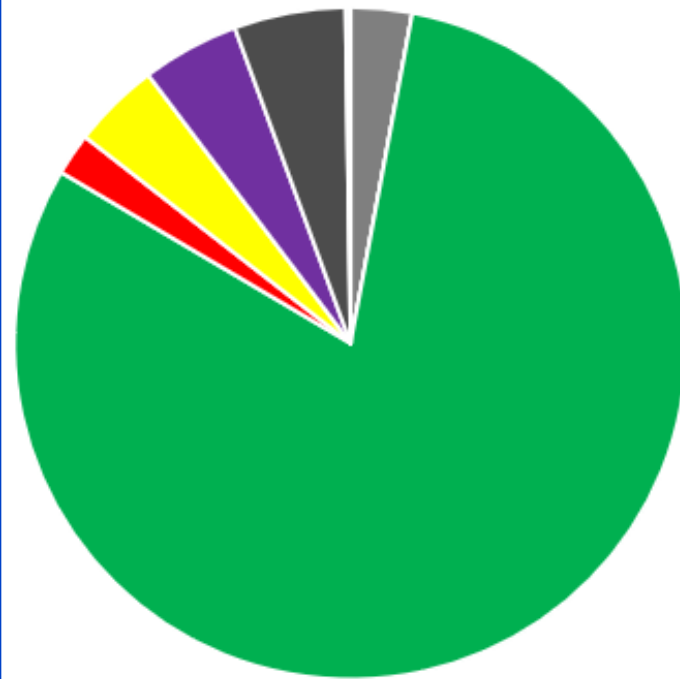

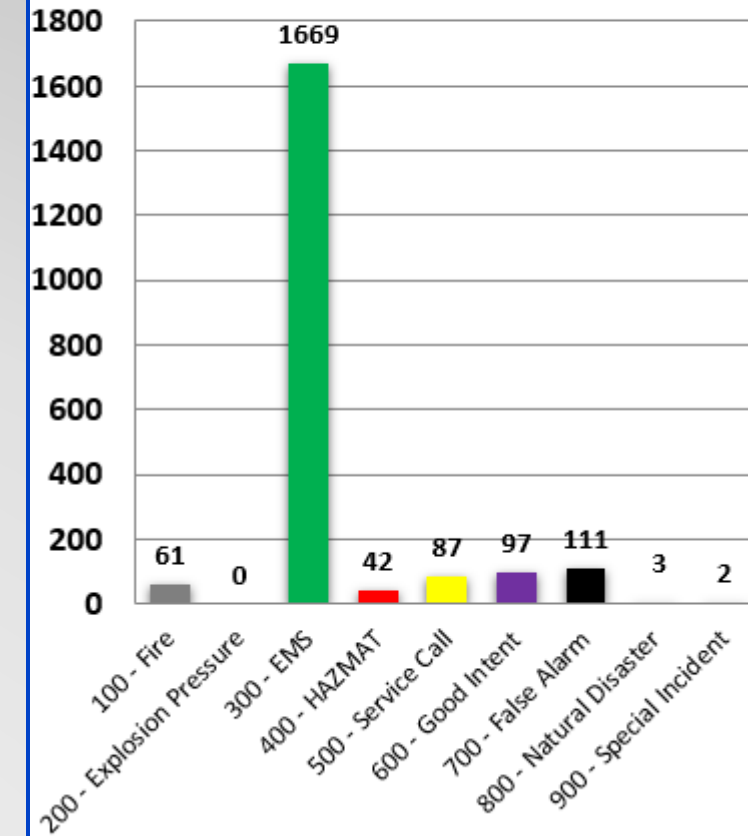

YTD Incident Types



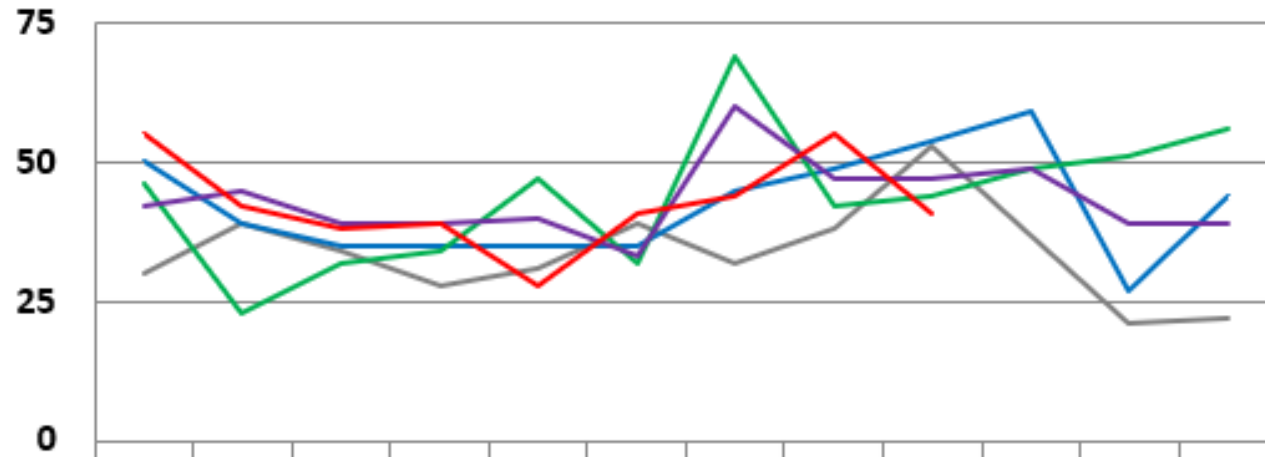
- 100 - Fire 2.9%

Call Volume Comparison

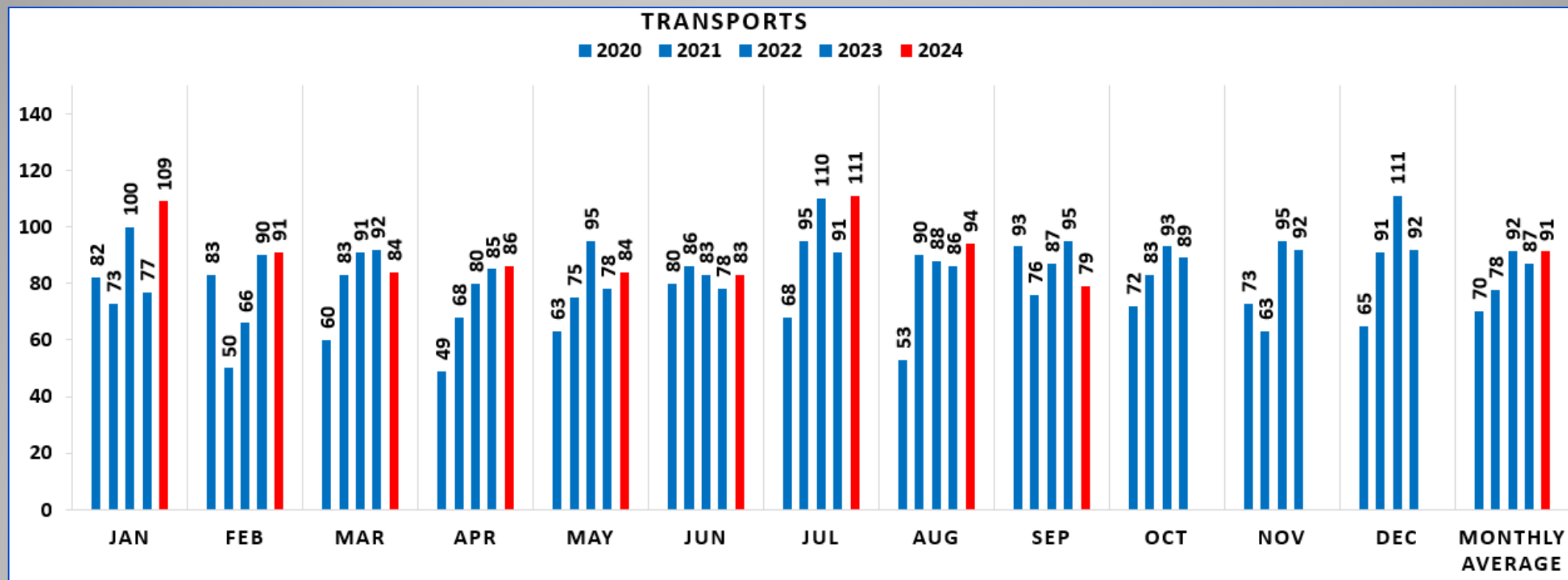
Monthly Concurrent Calls Comparison

- 2024 YTD Ambulance Transports = 821

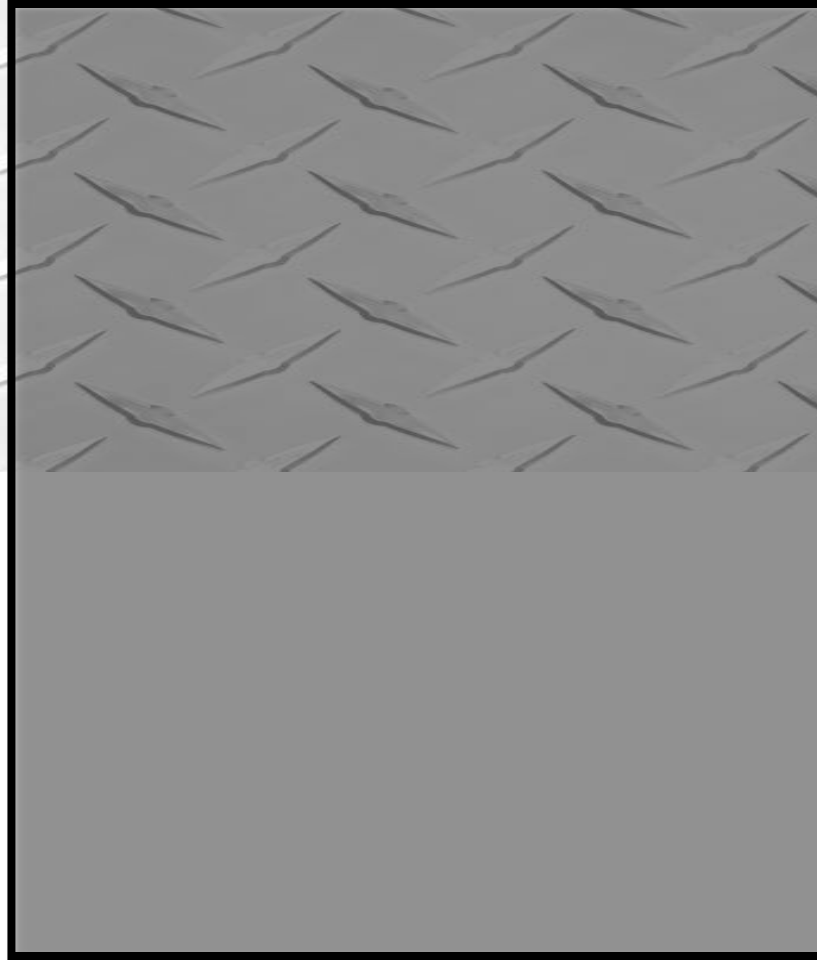
