- Construction work to begin in front of station 41 to replace part of the curb, gutter, and sidewalk

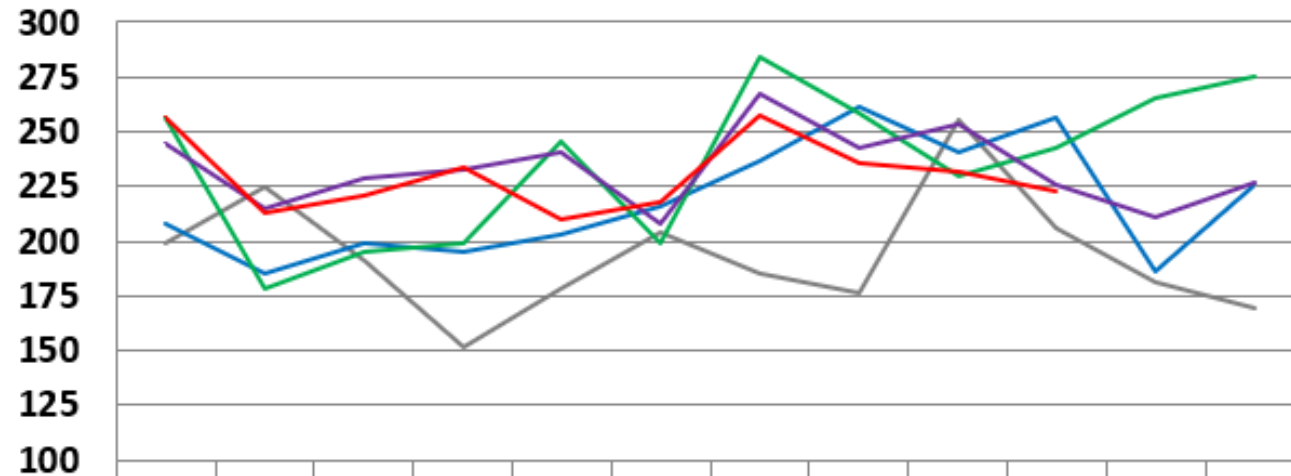


# St.41 Sidewalk and Ramp



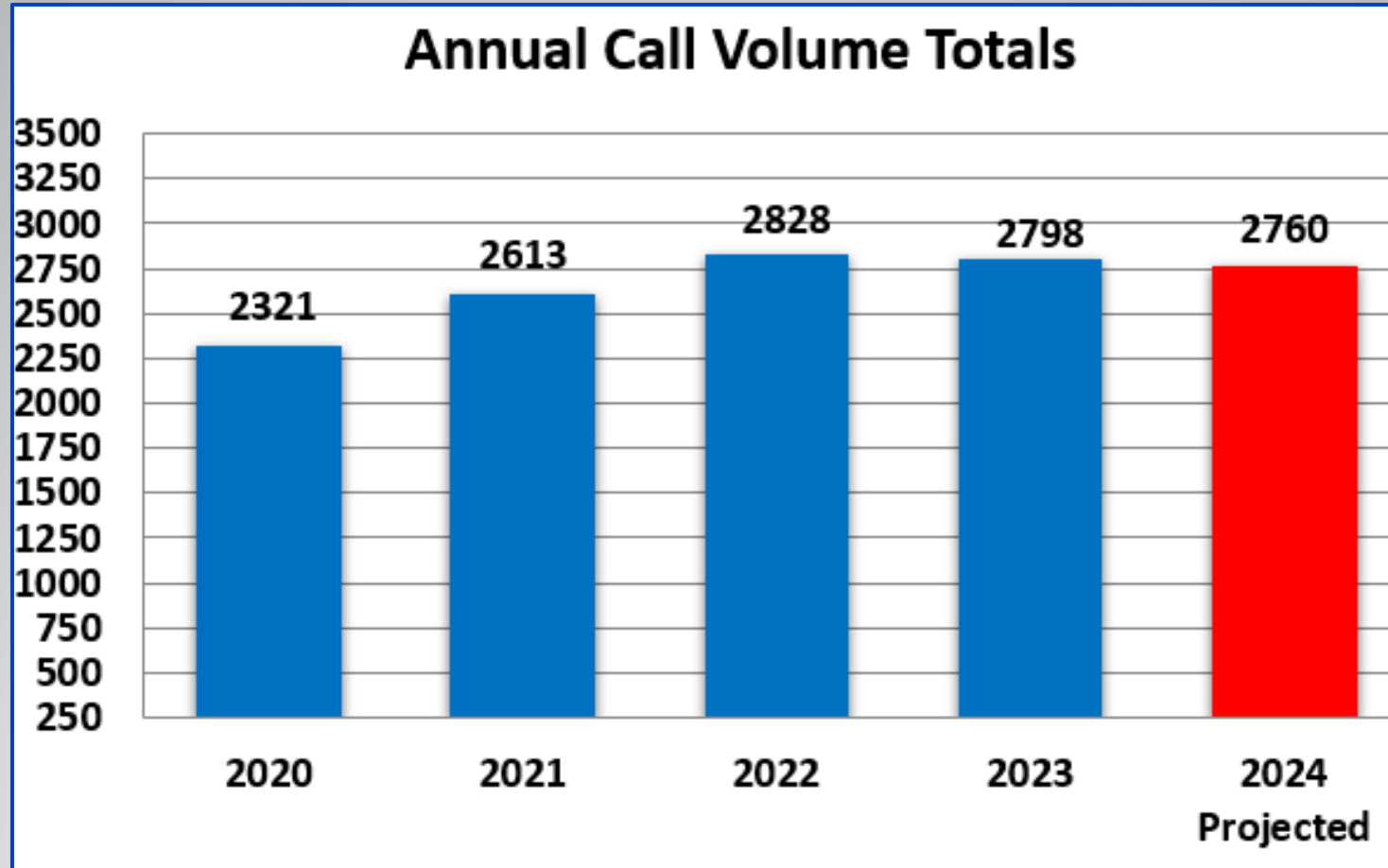

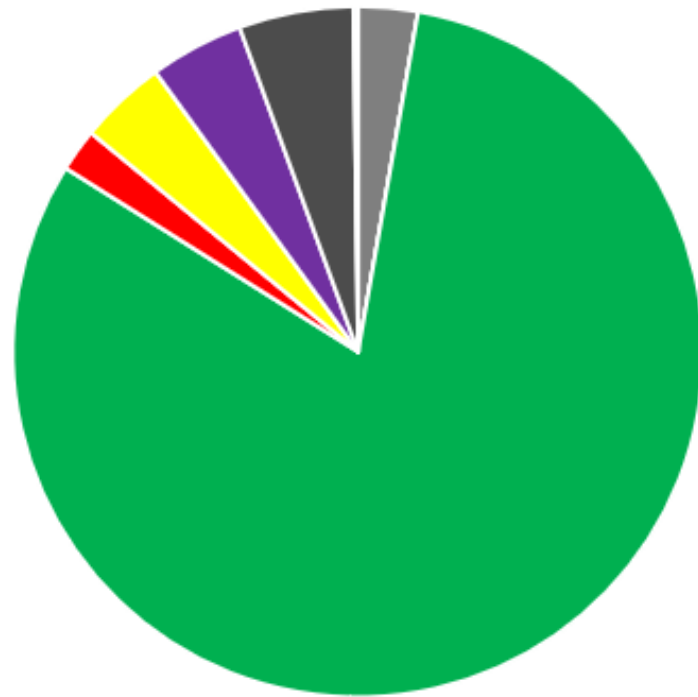

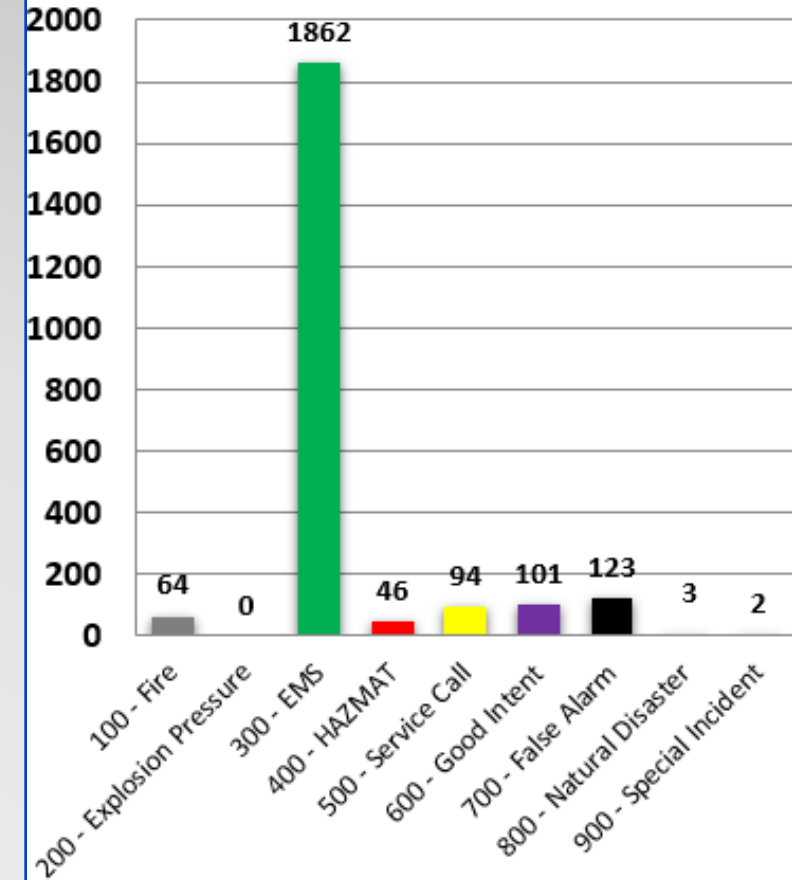


YTD Incident Types



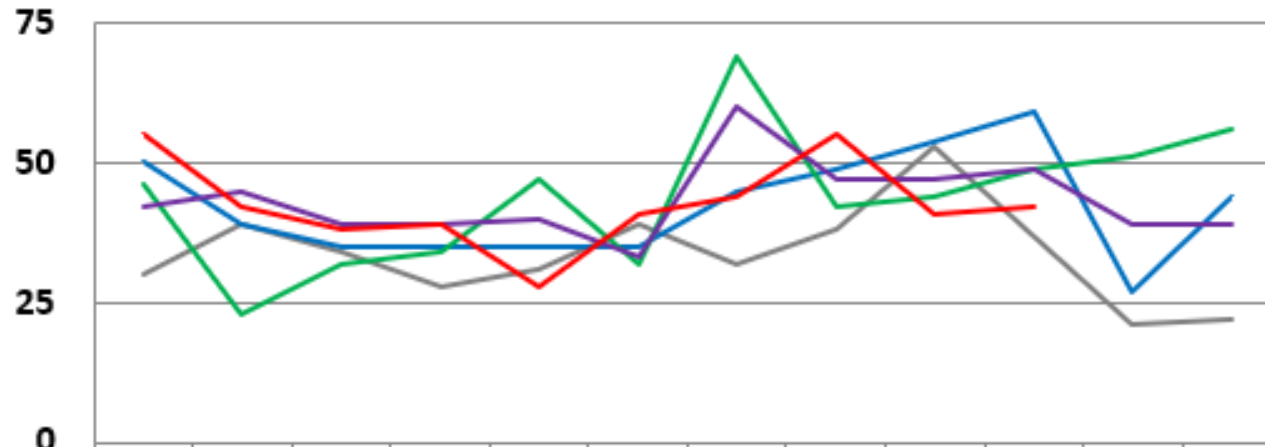

## Monthly Concurrent Calls Comparison

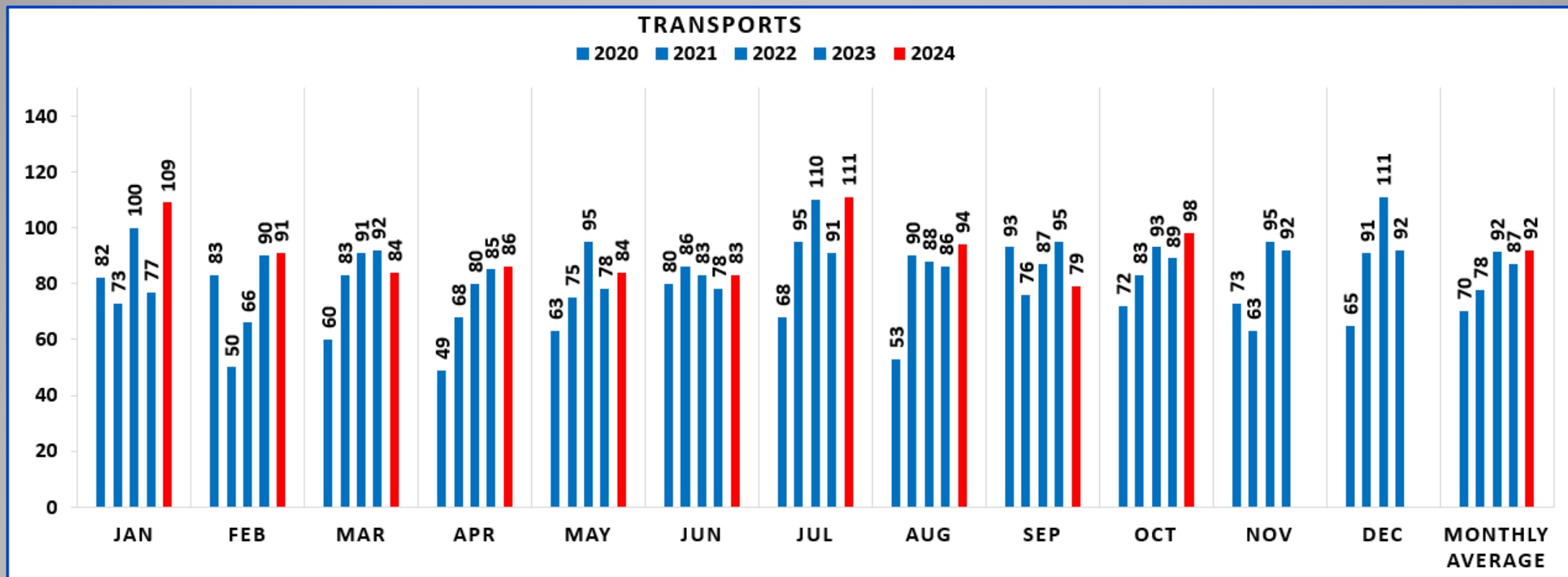


### Concurrent Call Average

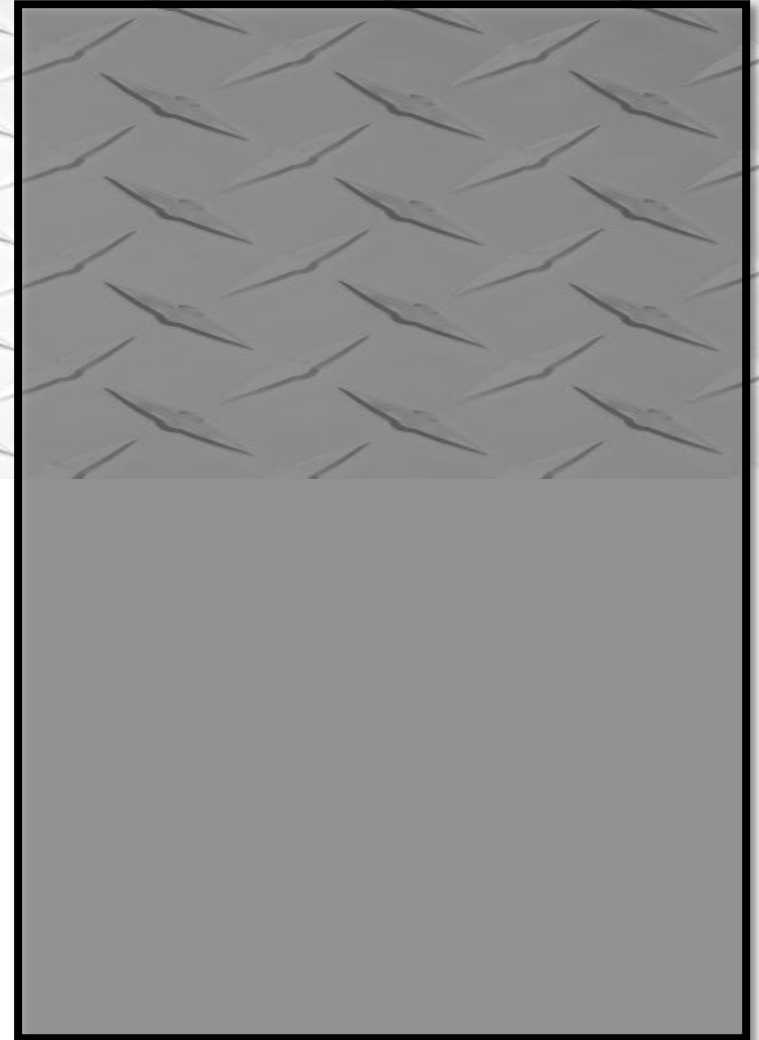

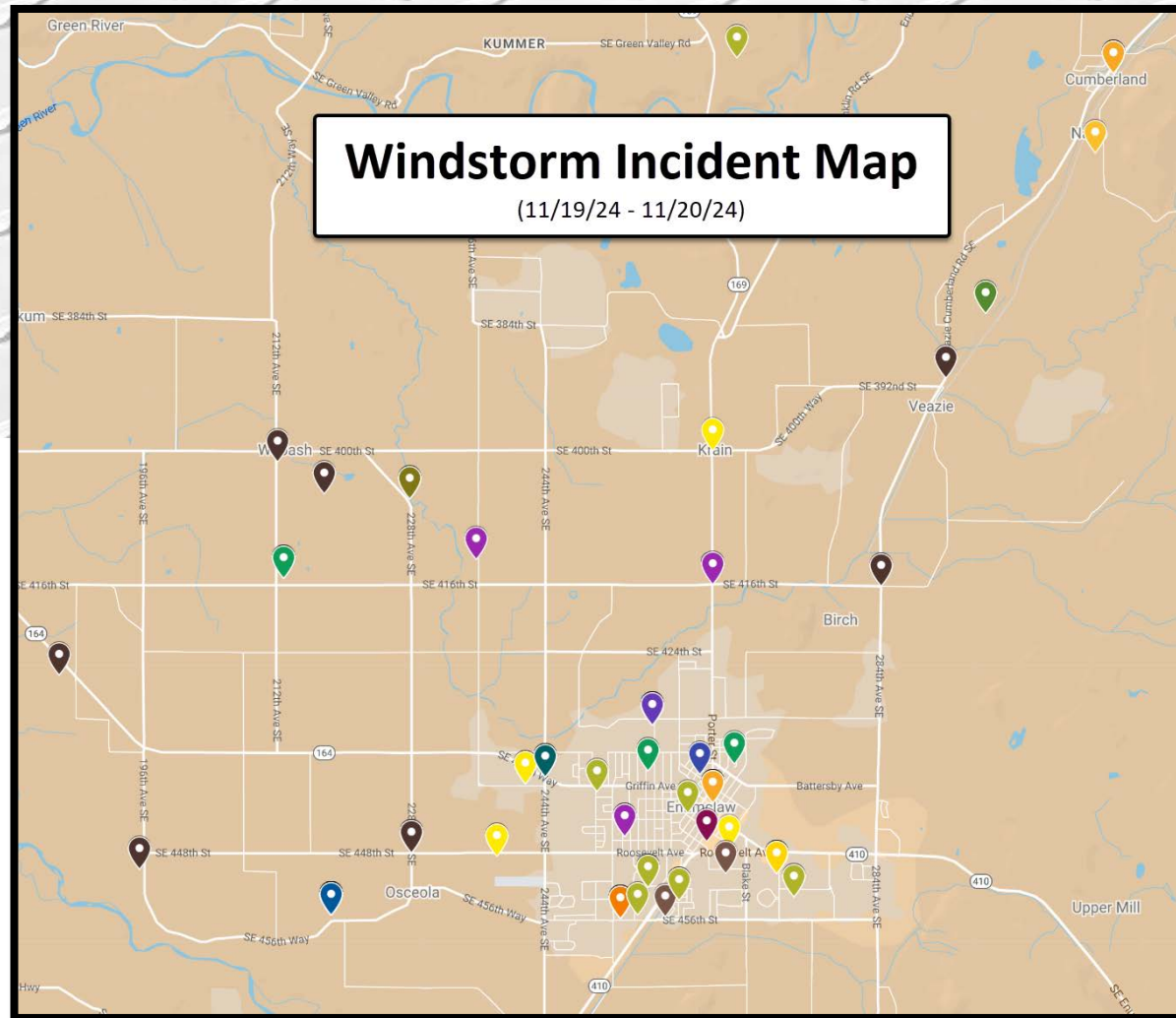
# Storm Report



- 11/19/2024 Windstorm Update:
  - Enumclaw Fire increased staffing in preparation for the storm
  - On 11/19/2024, we had 18 calls for service in just 7 hours; this is more than double our average daily call volume.
  - From 11/19 – 11/20 Enumclaw Fire had 40 calls for service
  - As a result of this storm, we have identified a few critical infrastructure areas within the Enumclaw Fire Department that need improvement.
