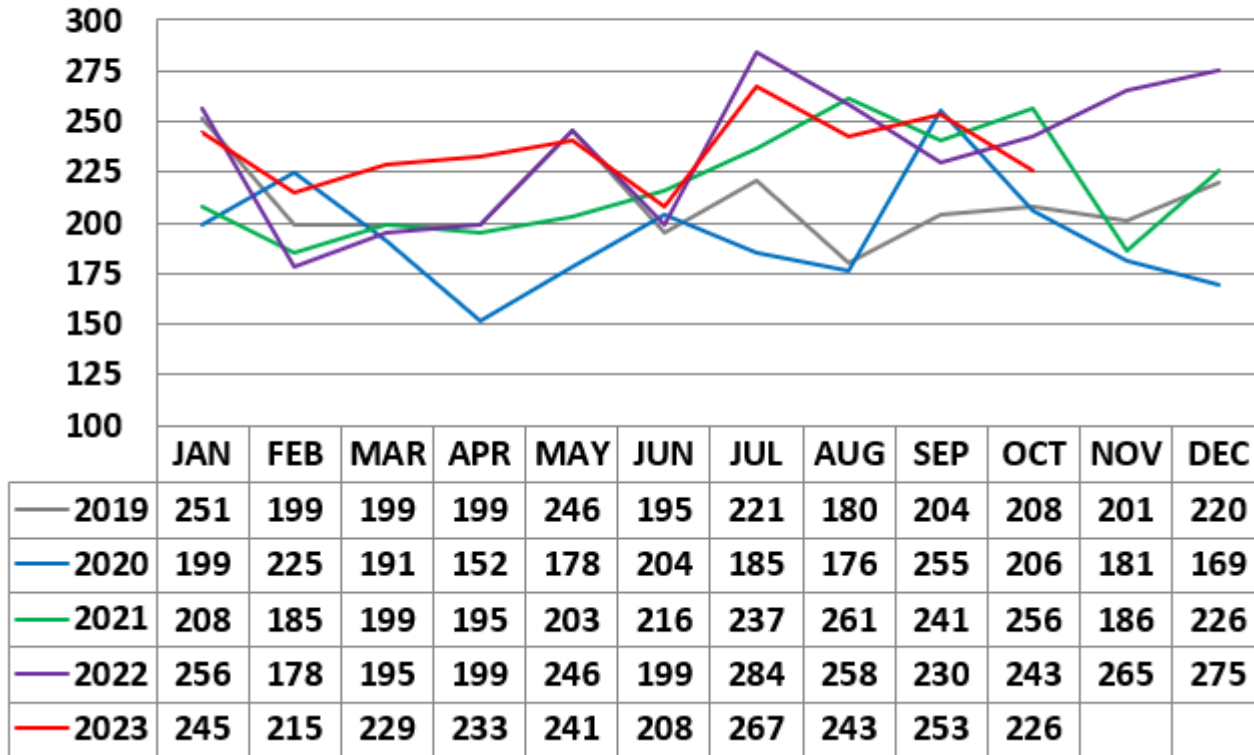

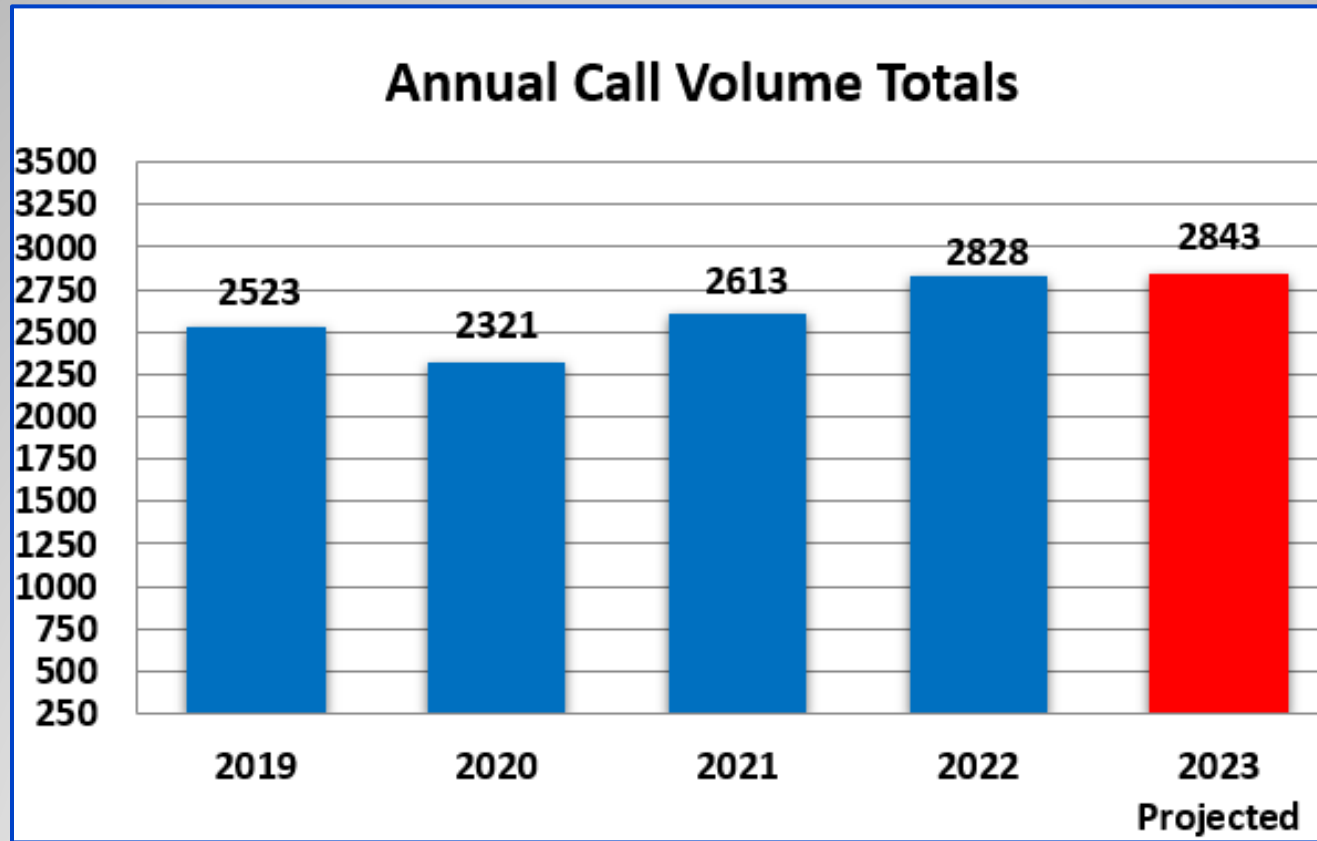


Call Volume

Monthly Call Volume Comparison

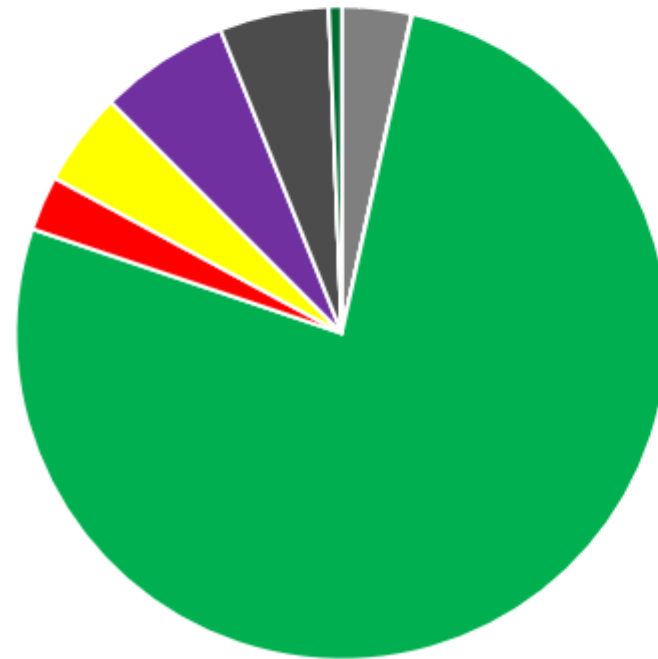

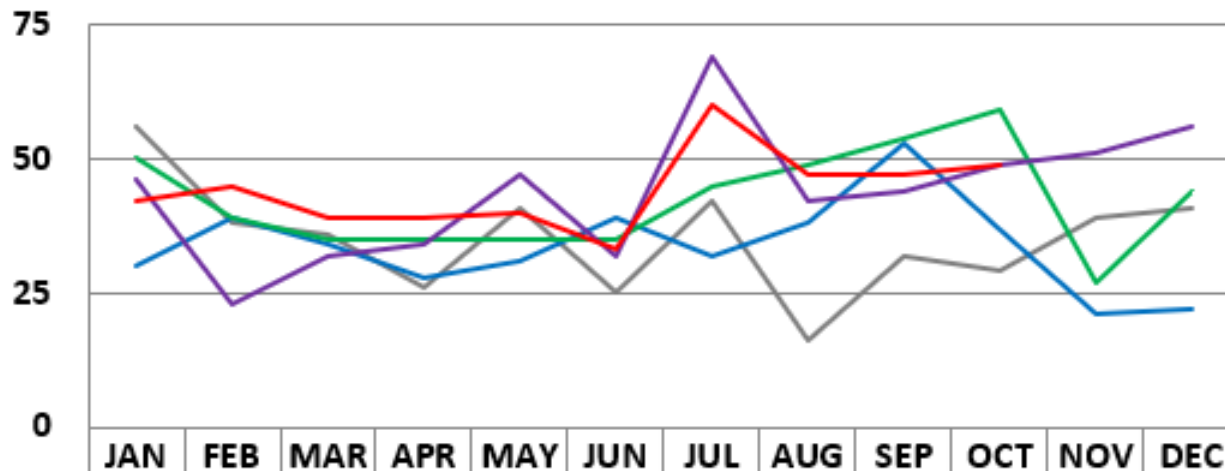
YTD Incident Types

Call Volume Comparison

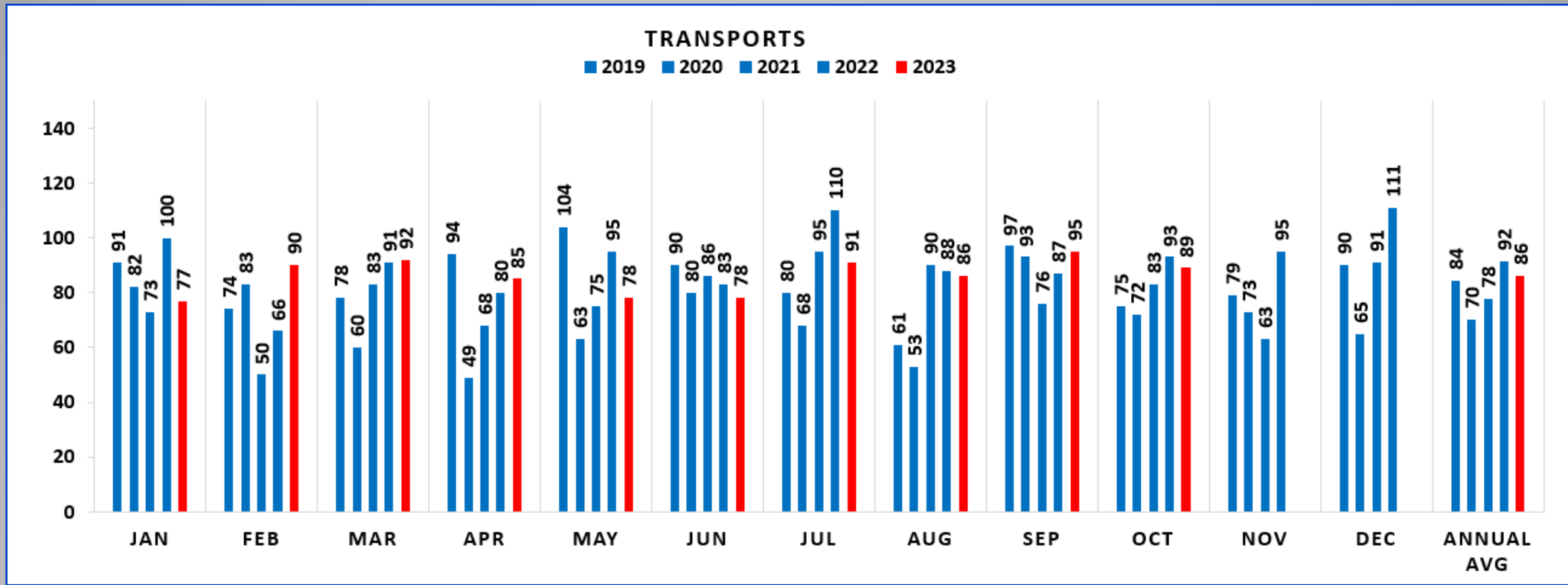
Monthly Concurrent Calls Comparison

Transport Yearly Totals

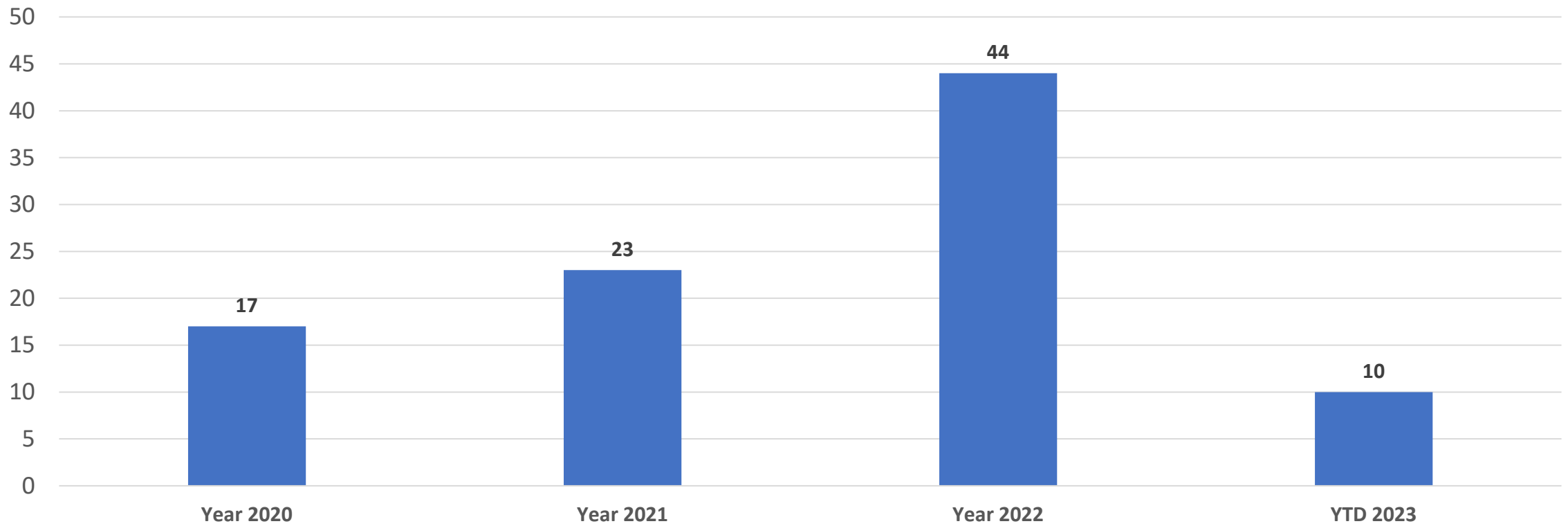

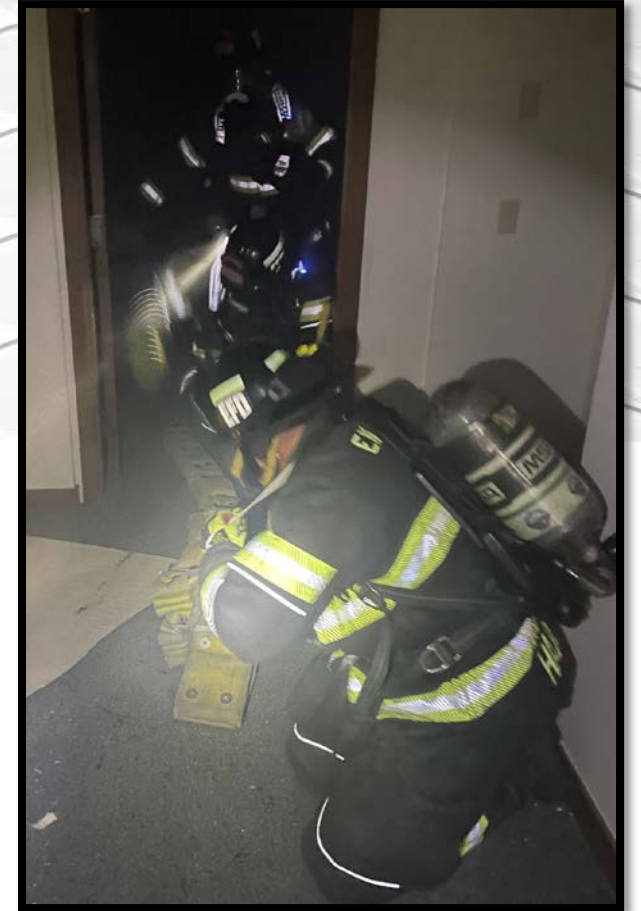

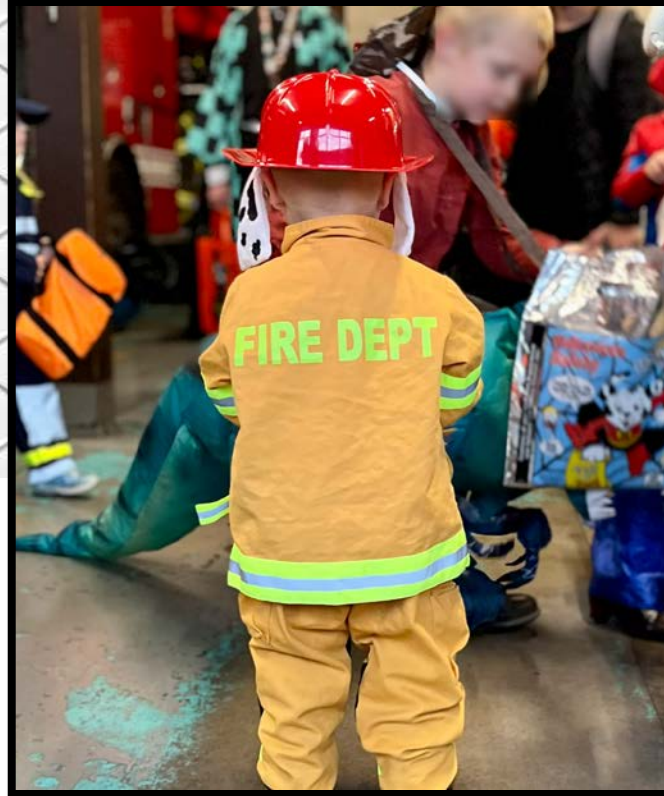
