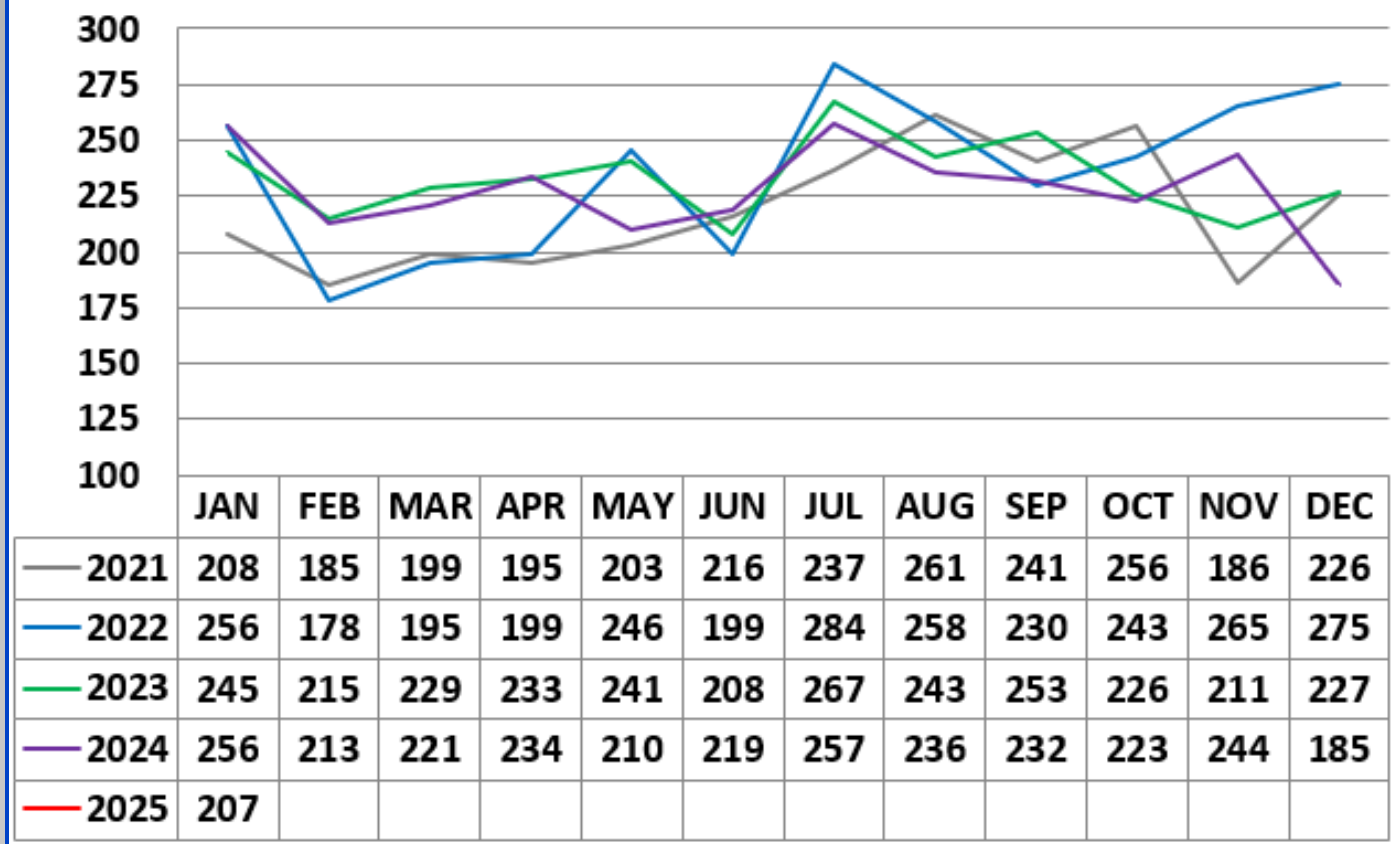

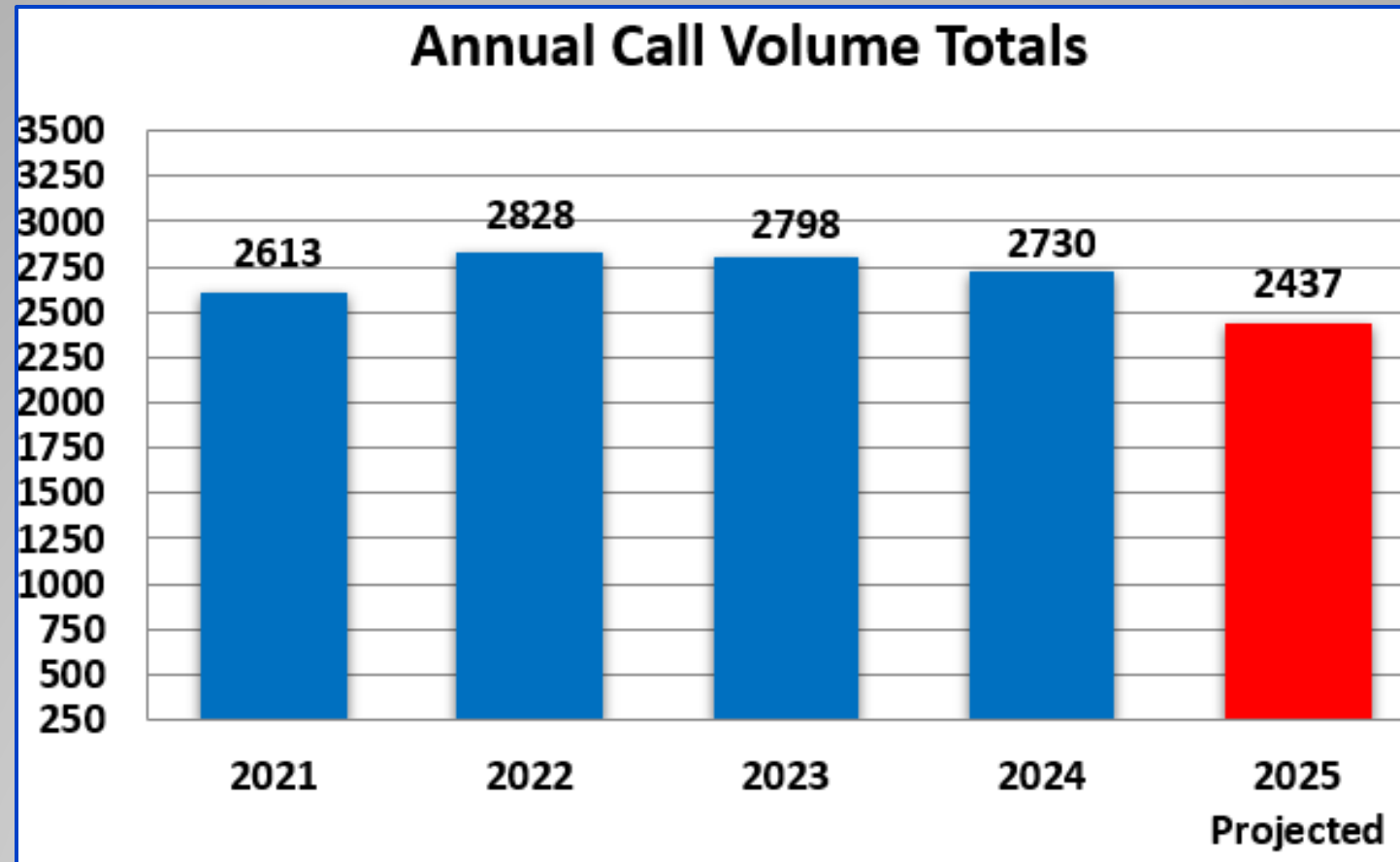

Monthly Call Volume Comparison

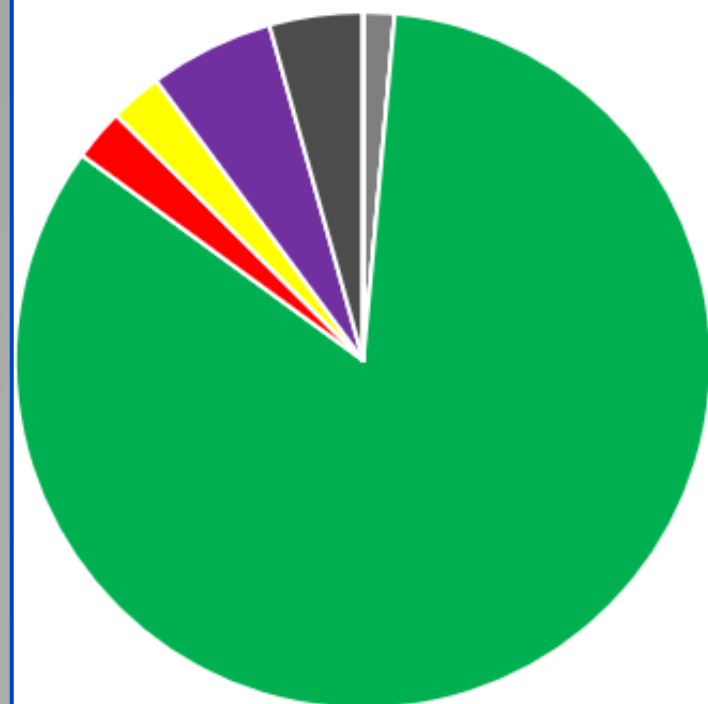


Monthly - Call Volume Comparison



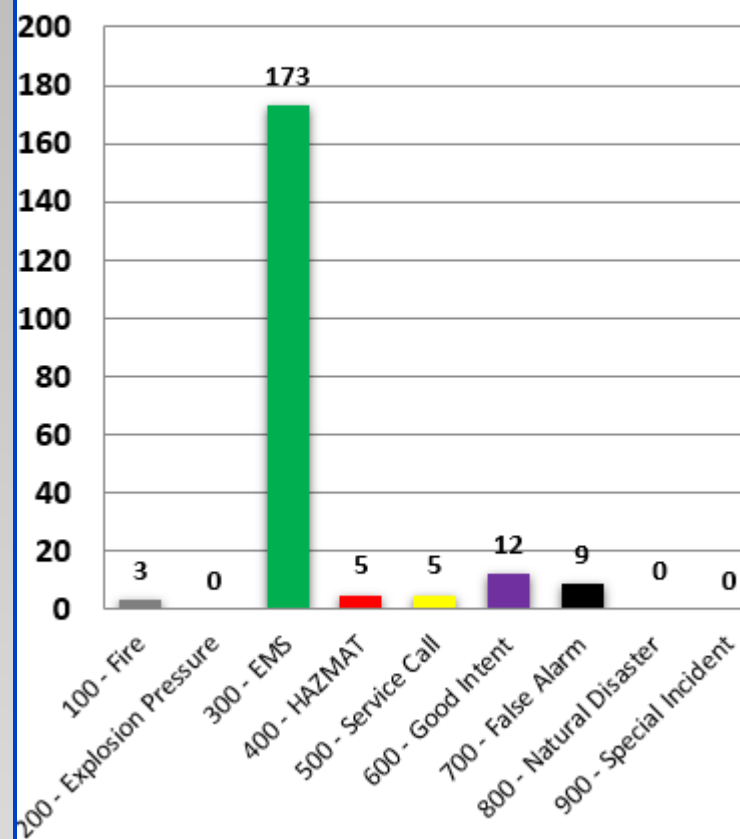
Annual - Call Volume Comparison

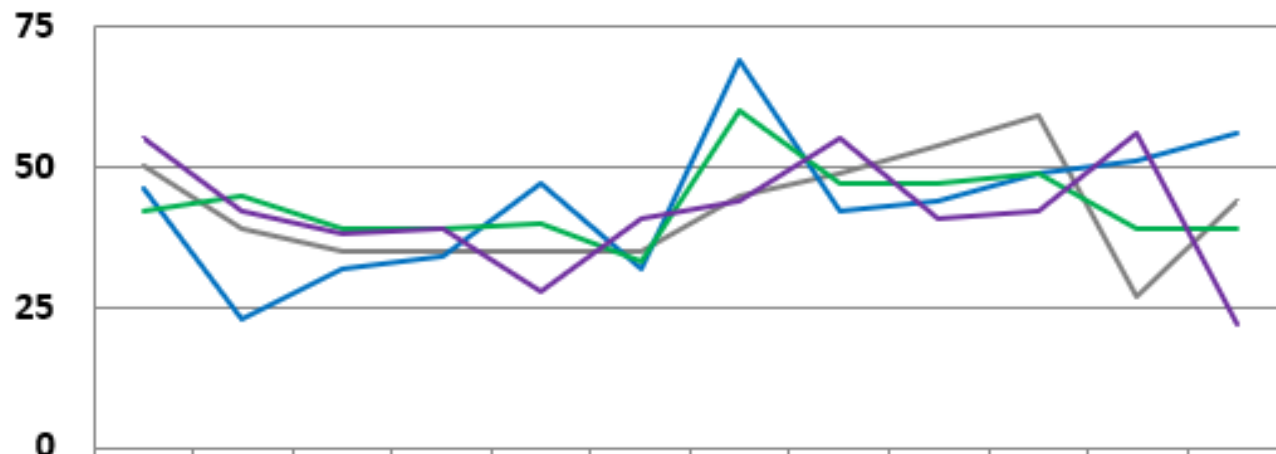
YTD Incident Types

Monthly Concurrent Calls Comparison

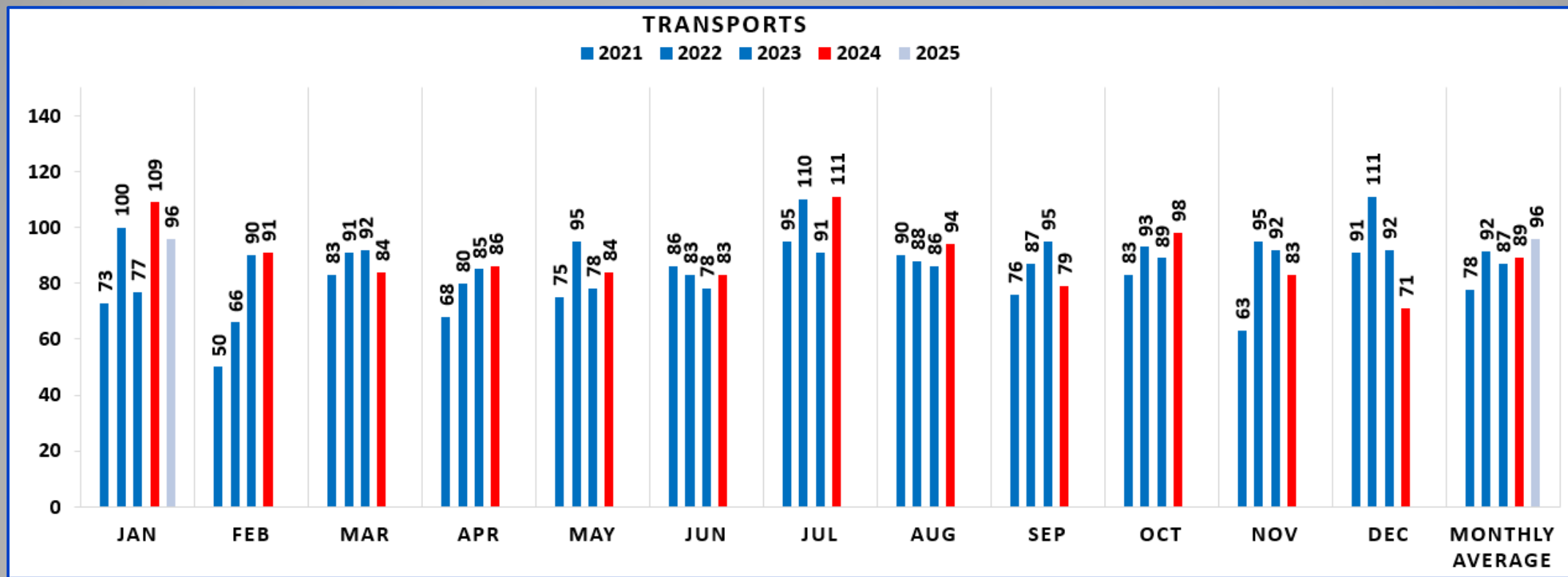
