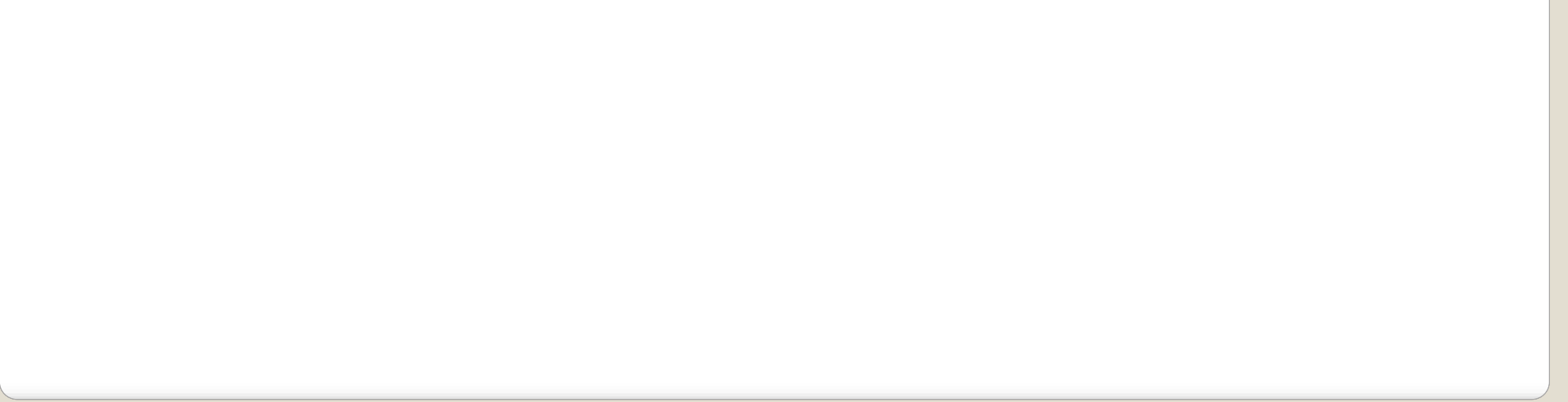


Follow up/Information

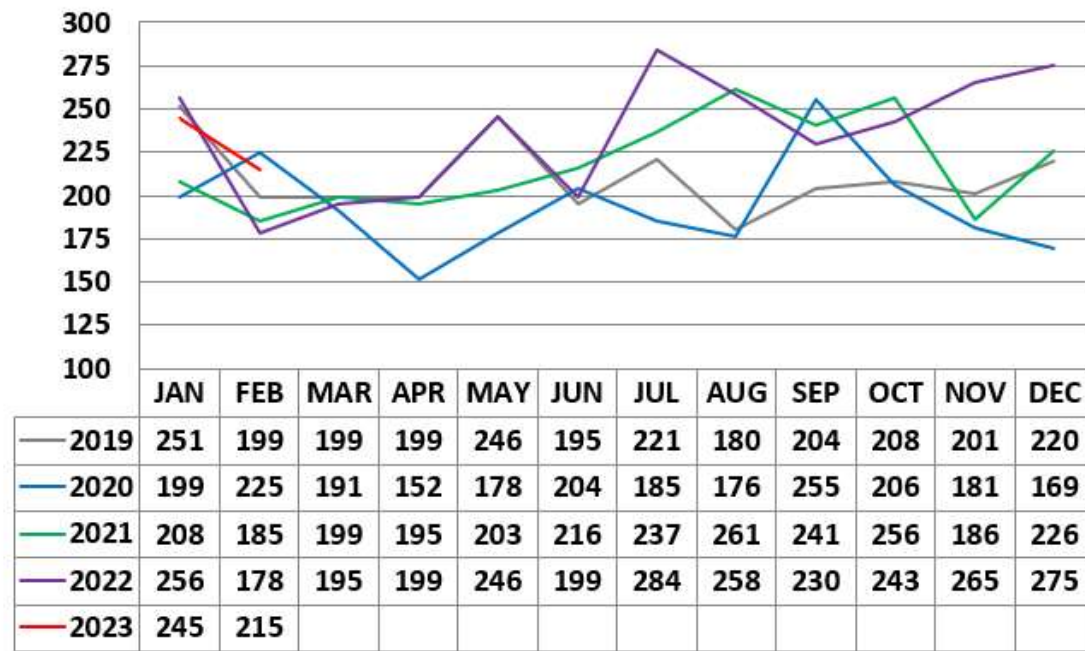
- Multiple long-term vacancies

- PSERN radio installation and upgrade have started



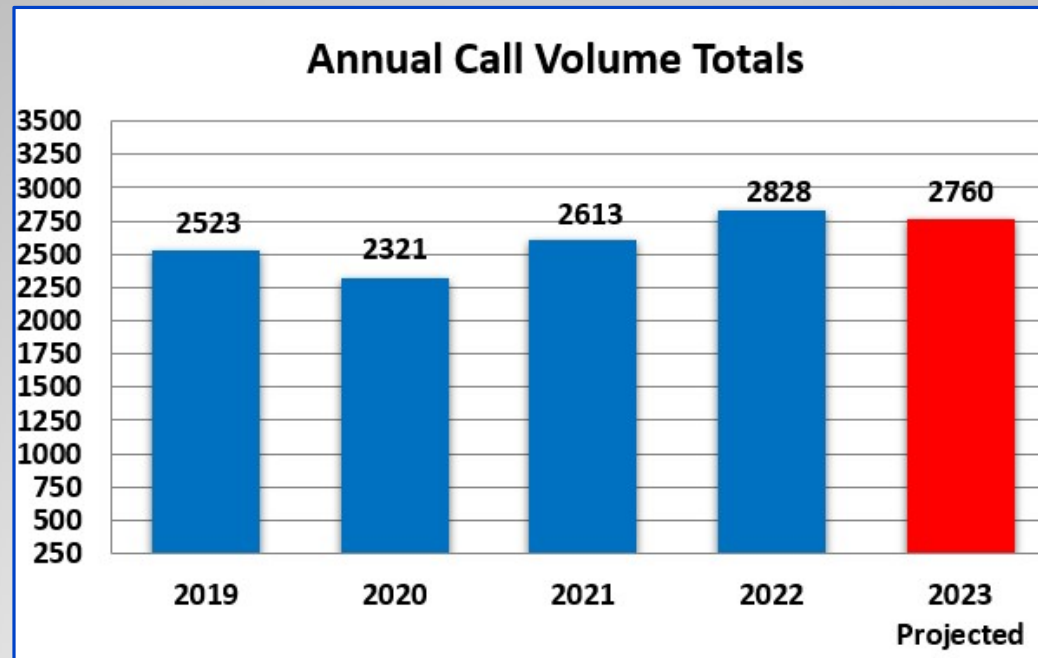
Call Volume



Monthly Call Volume Comparison

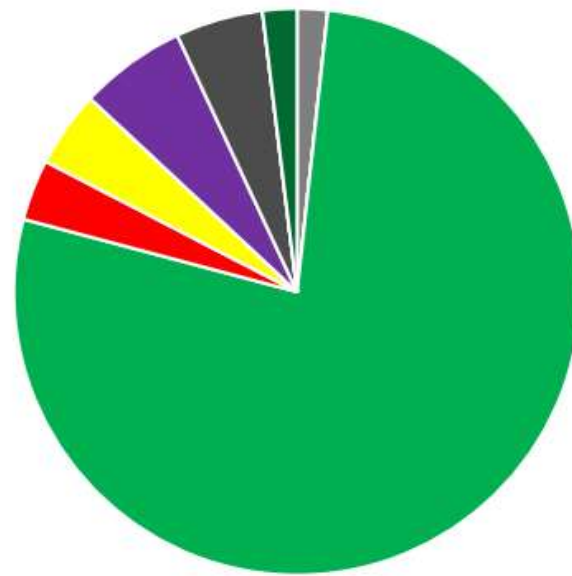

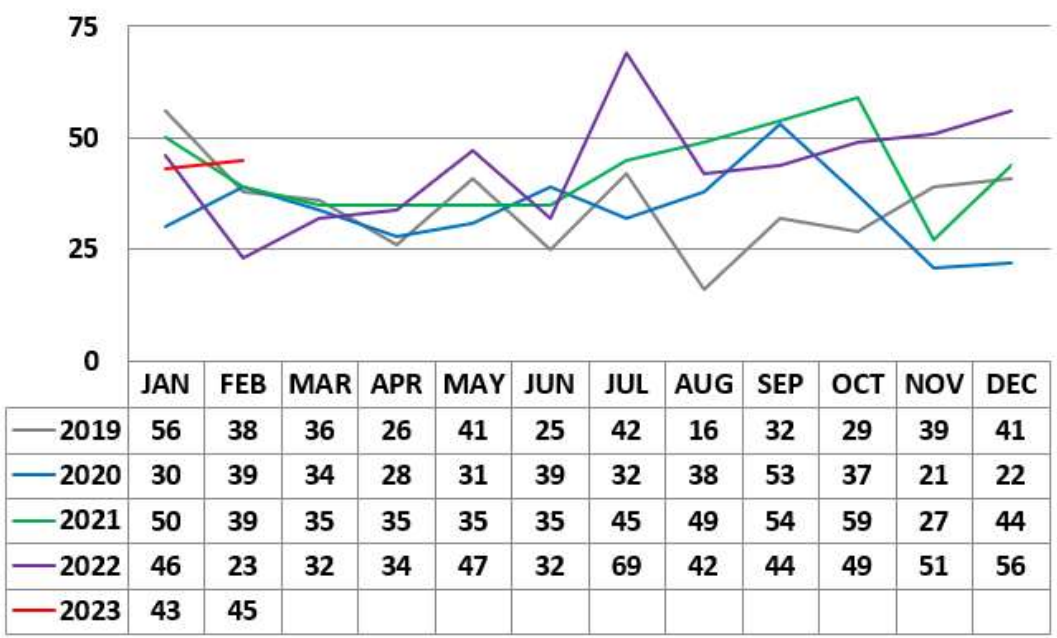
YTD Incident Types

Call Volume Comparison

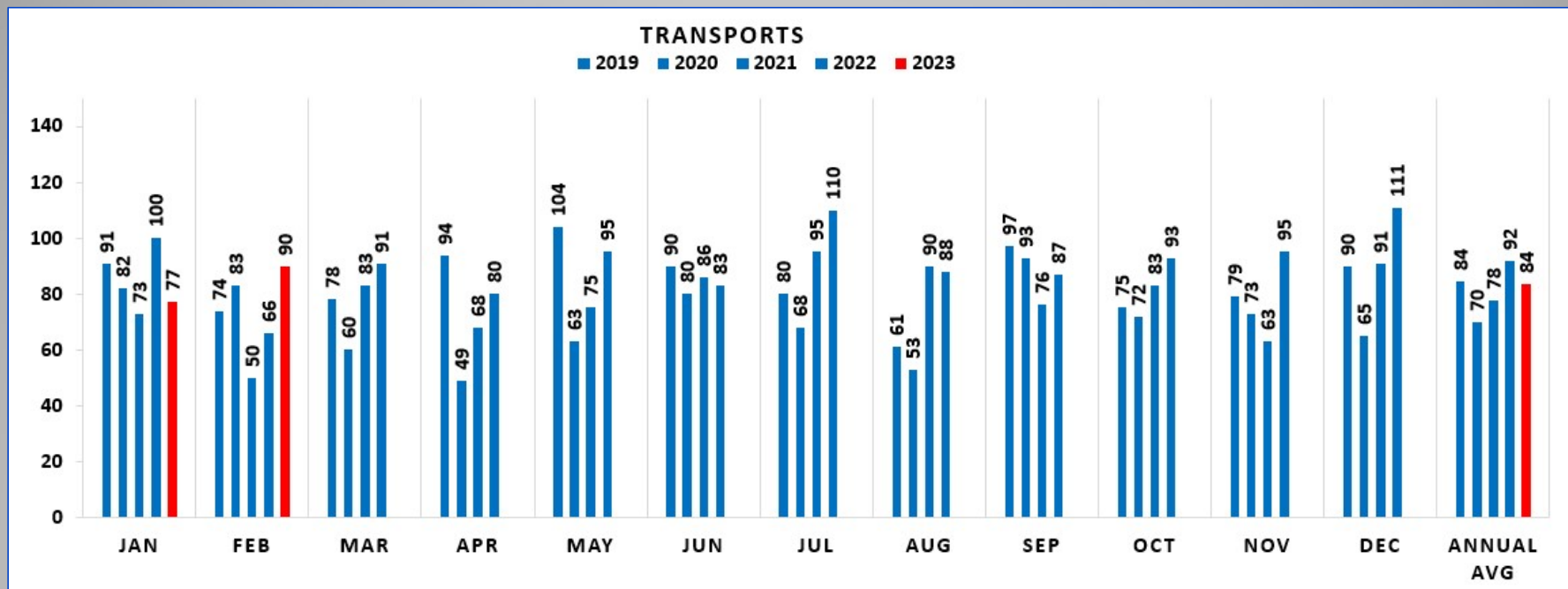
Monthly Concurrent Calls Comparison

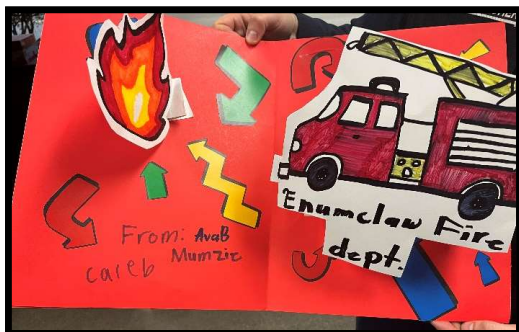
