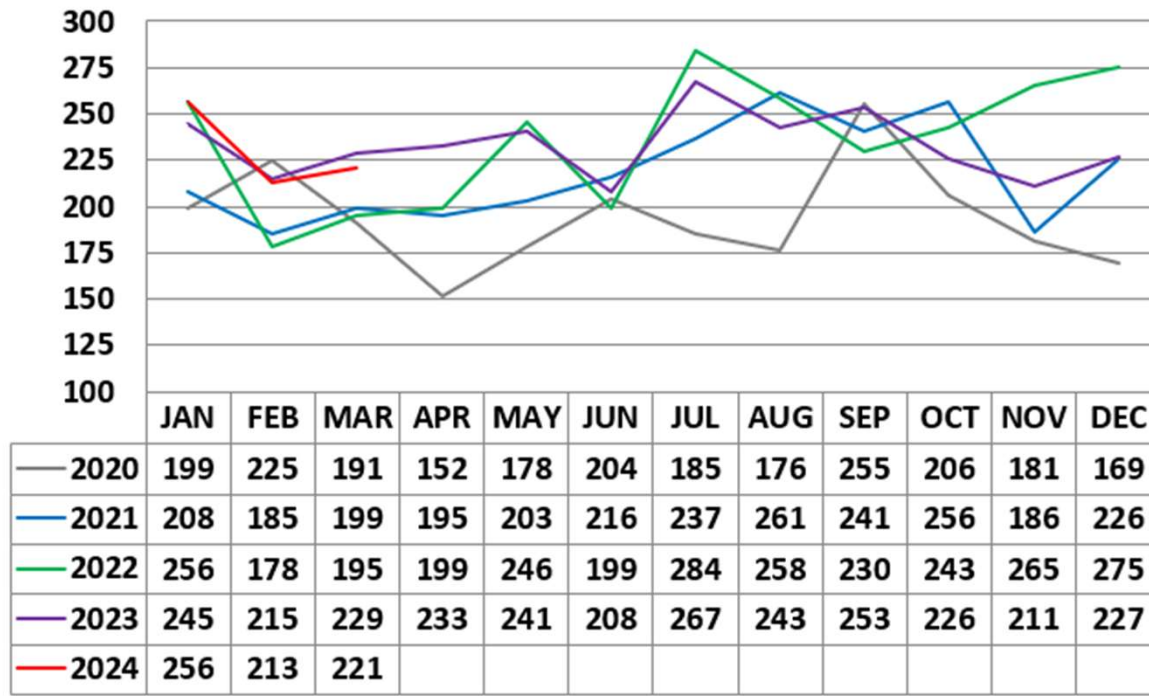
Follow up/Information

- Training prop update.

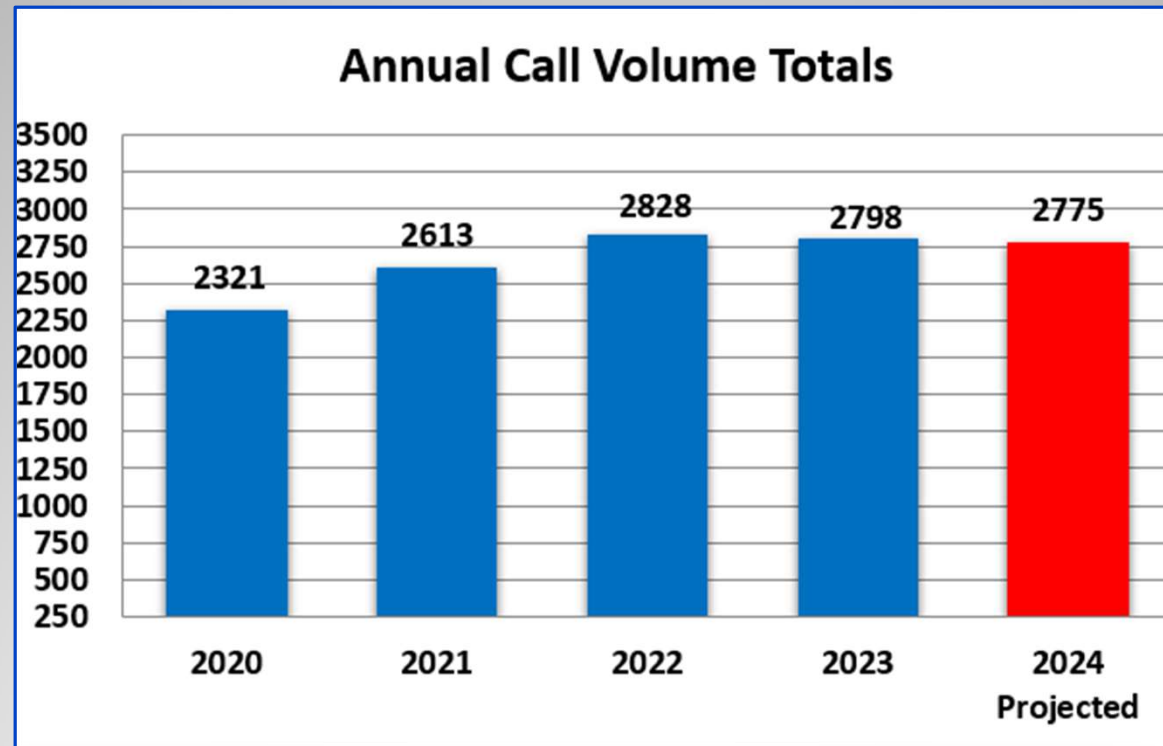


Call Volume

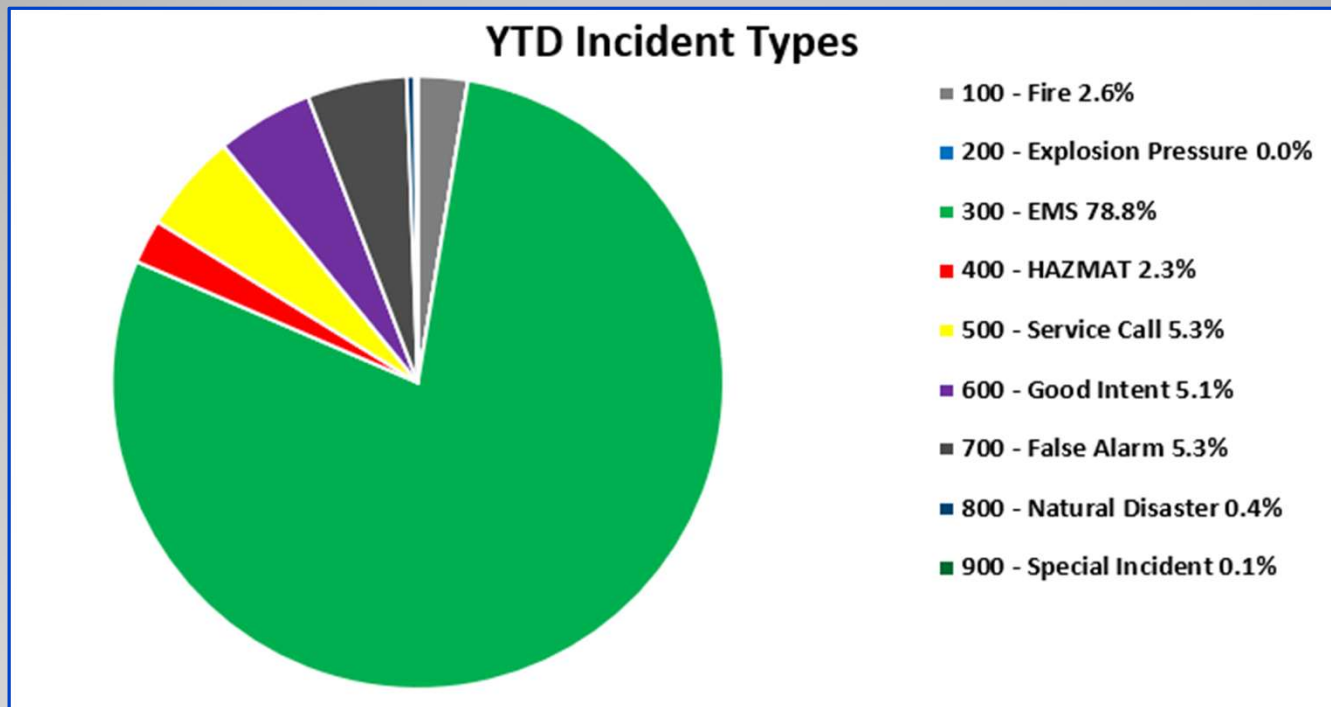
Monthly Call Volume Comparison



Call Volume Comparison

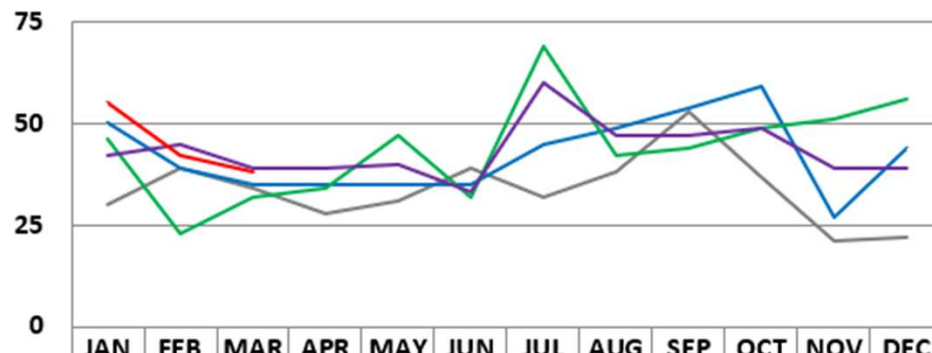

Monthly Concurrent Calls Comparison

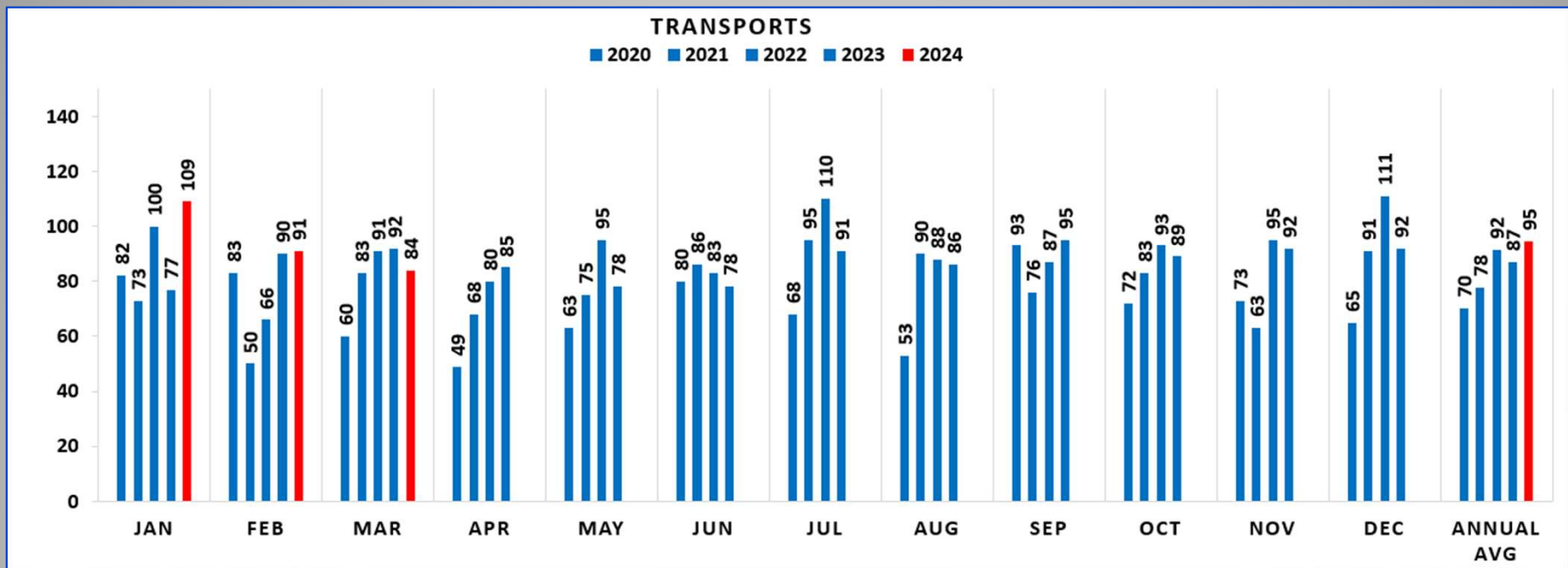
