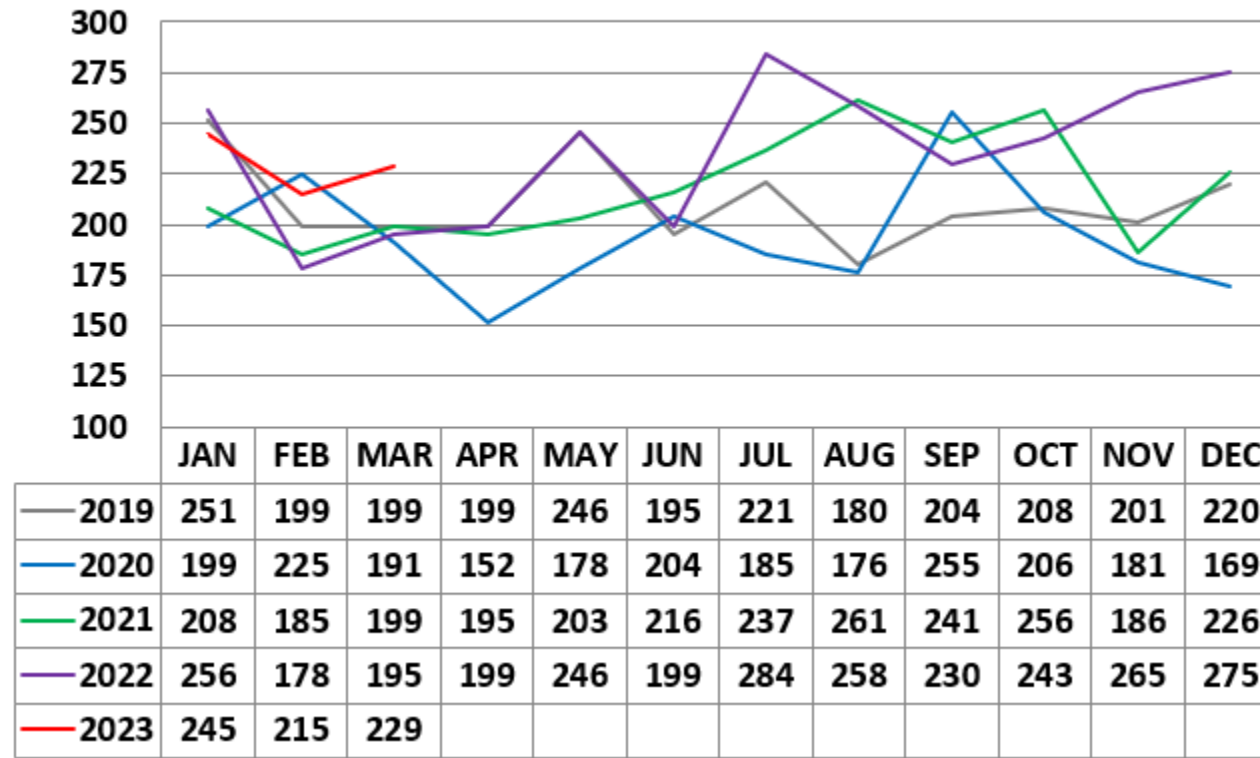
Follow up/Information

- WHCA had a webinar for long term care facilities in King County regarding the use of 911

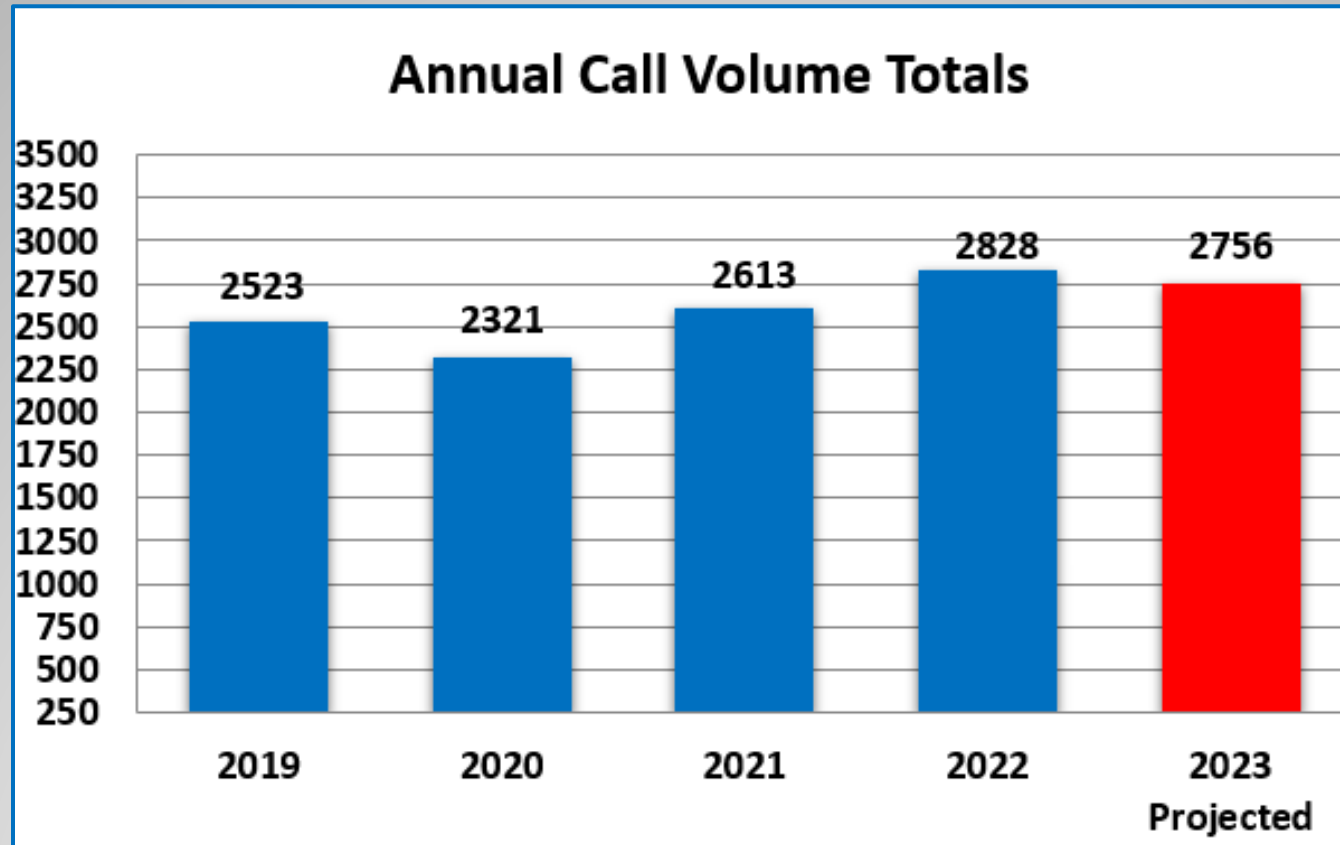


Call Volume

Monthly Call Volume Comparison

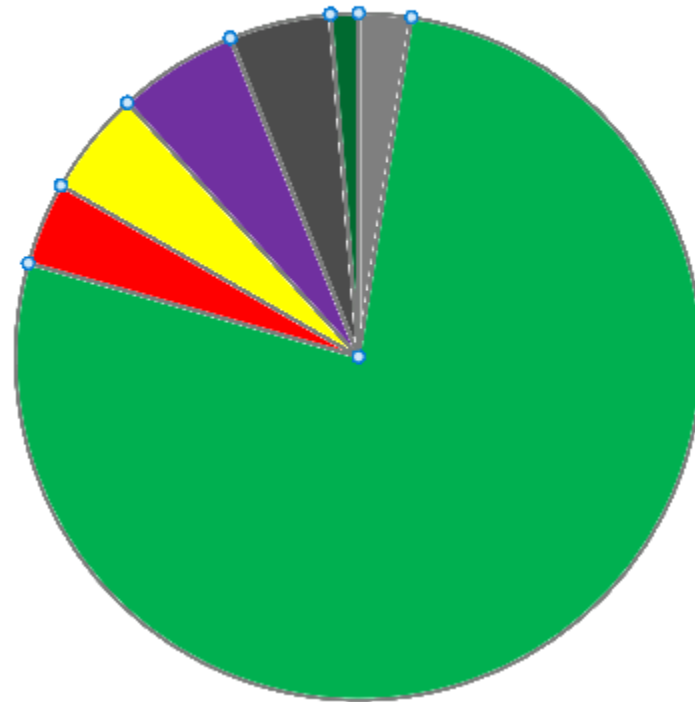

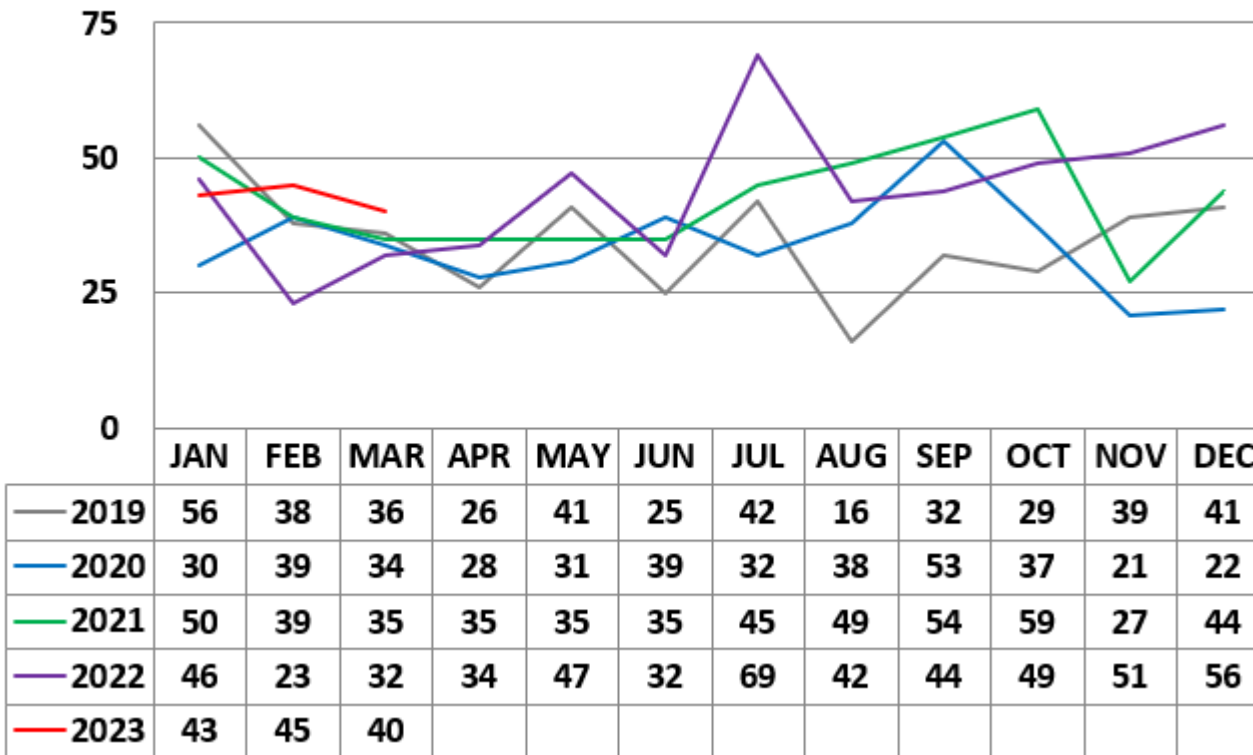
YTD Incident Types

Monthly Concurrent Calls Comparison

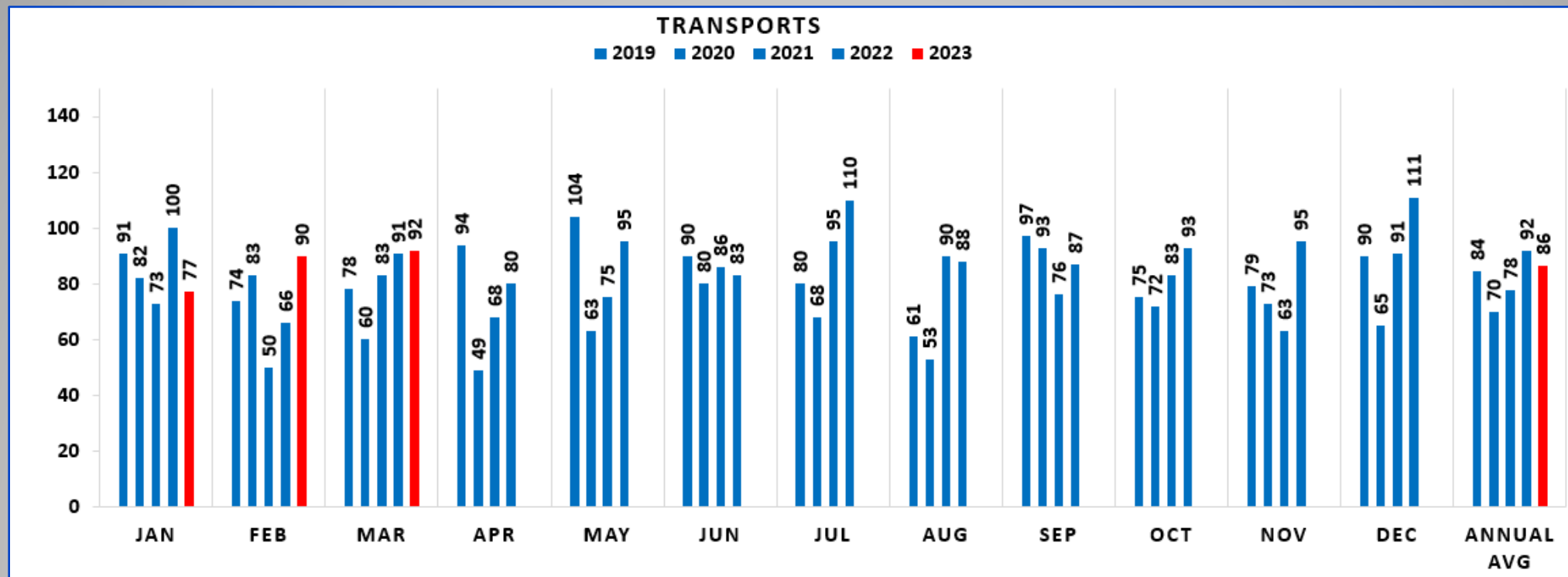


Concurrent call Average
