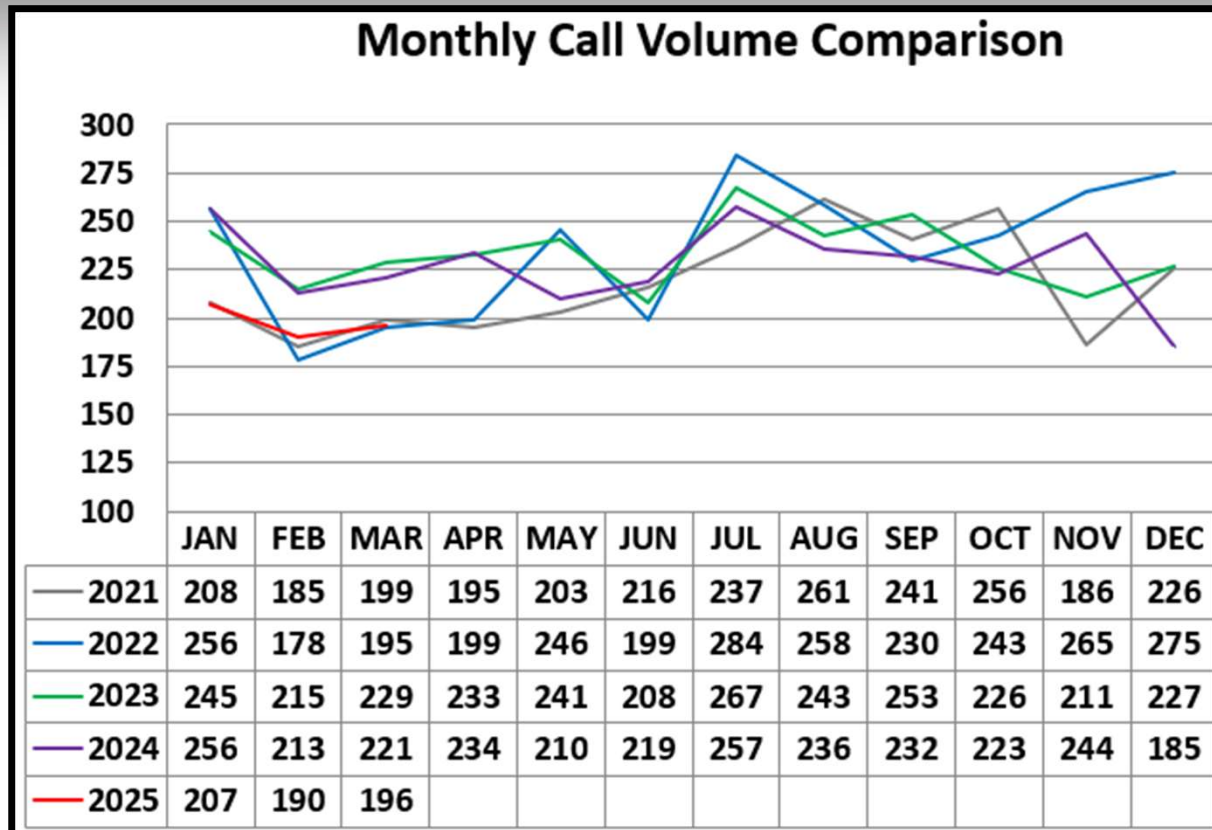

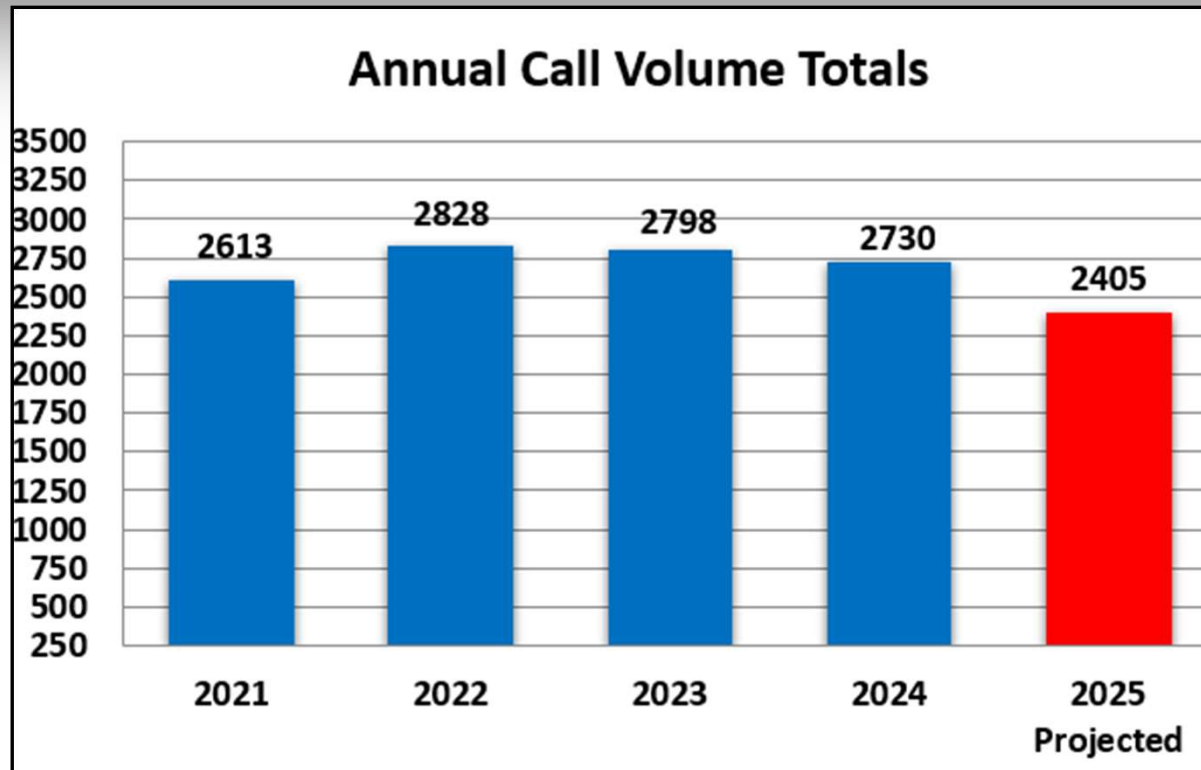








# Call Volume Projections - Annual

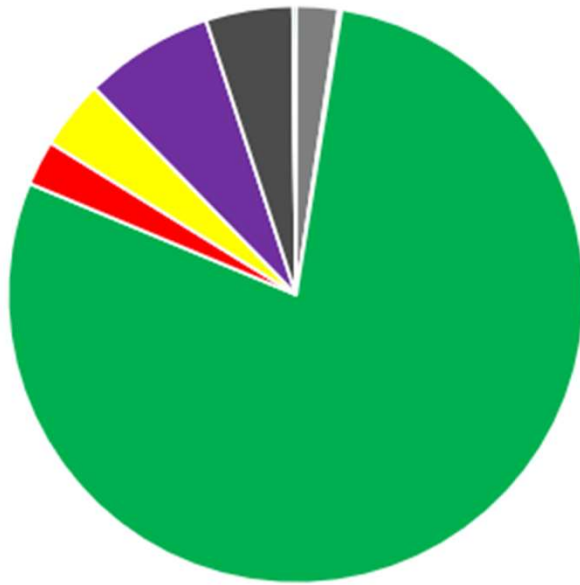




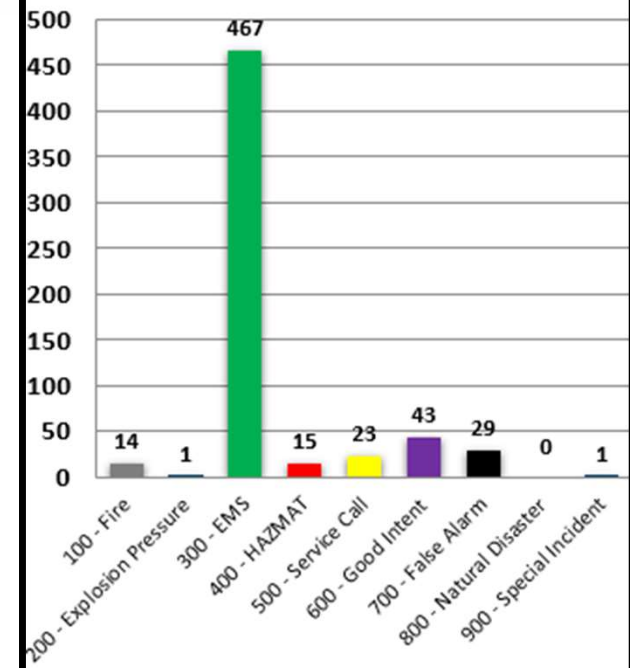
# Incidents by Call Type – Year-to-Date

- 700 - False Alarm 4.9%
- 800 - Natural Disaster 0.0%

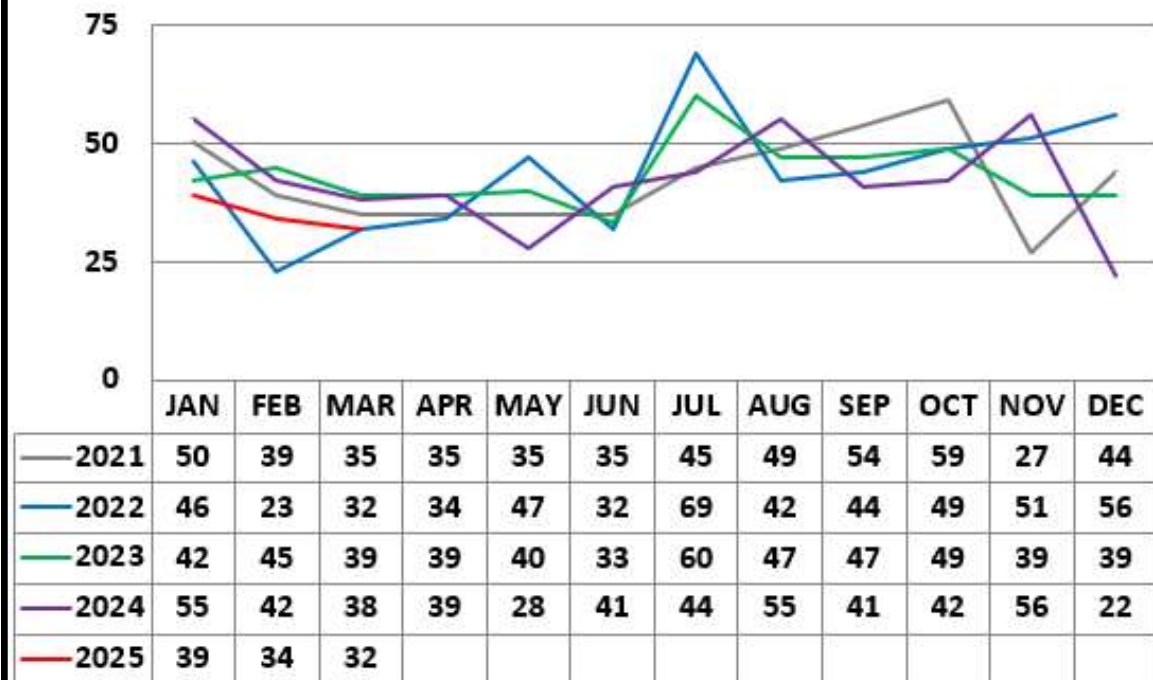






# Concurrent Calls Comparison - Monthly

Monthly Concurrent Calls Comparison

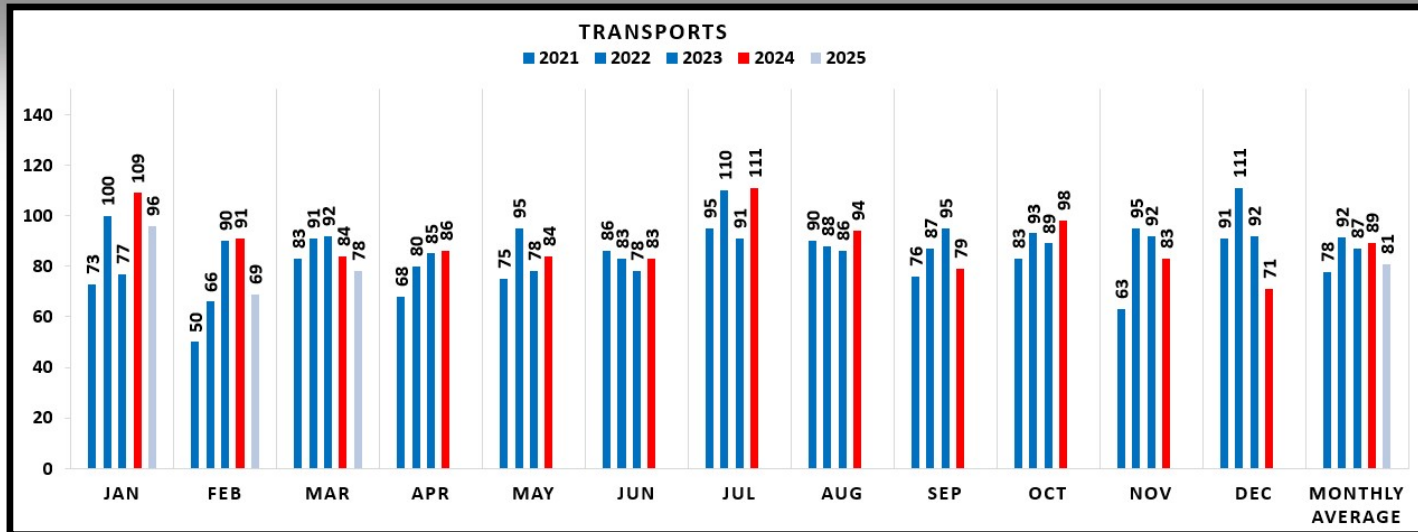


## Concurrent Call Average
