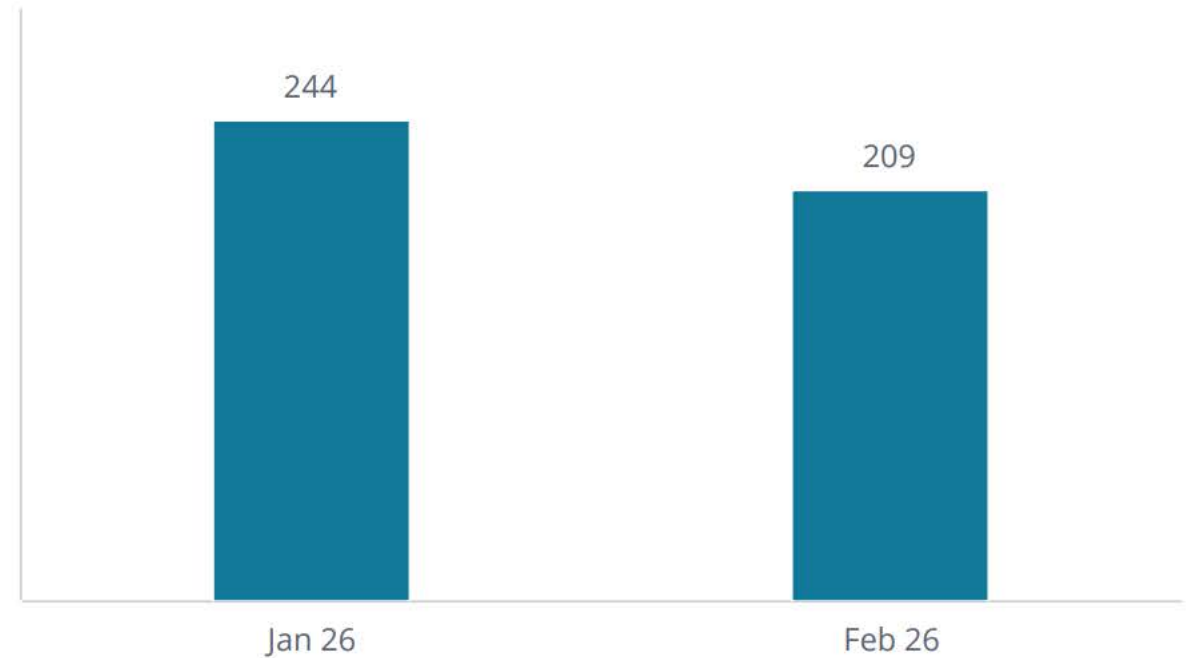

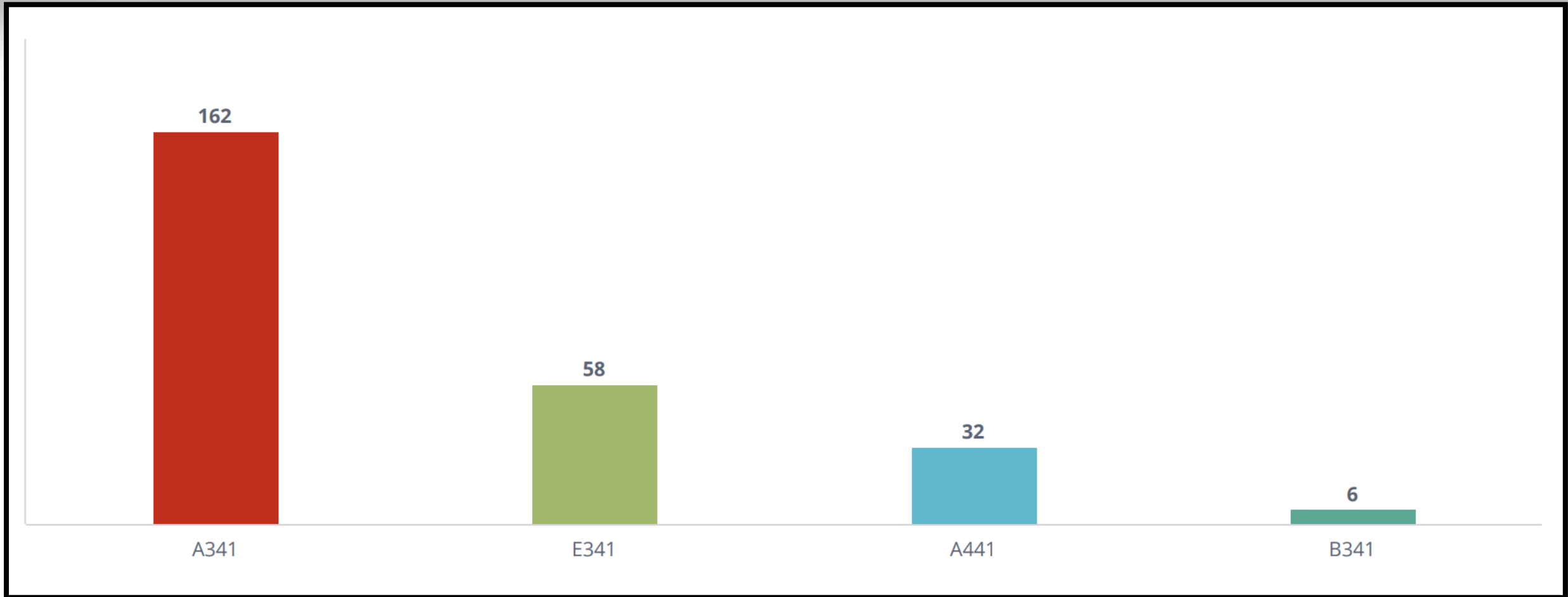

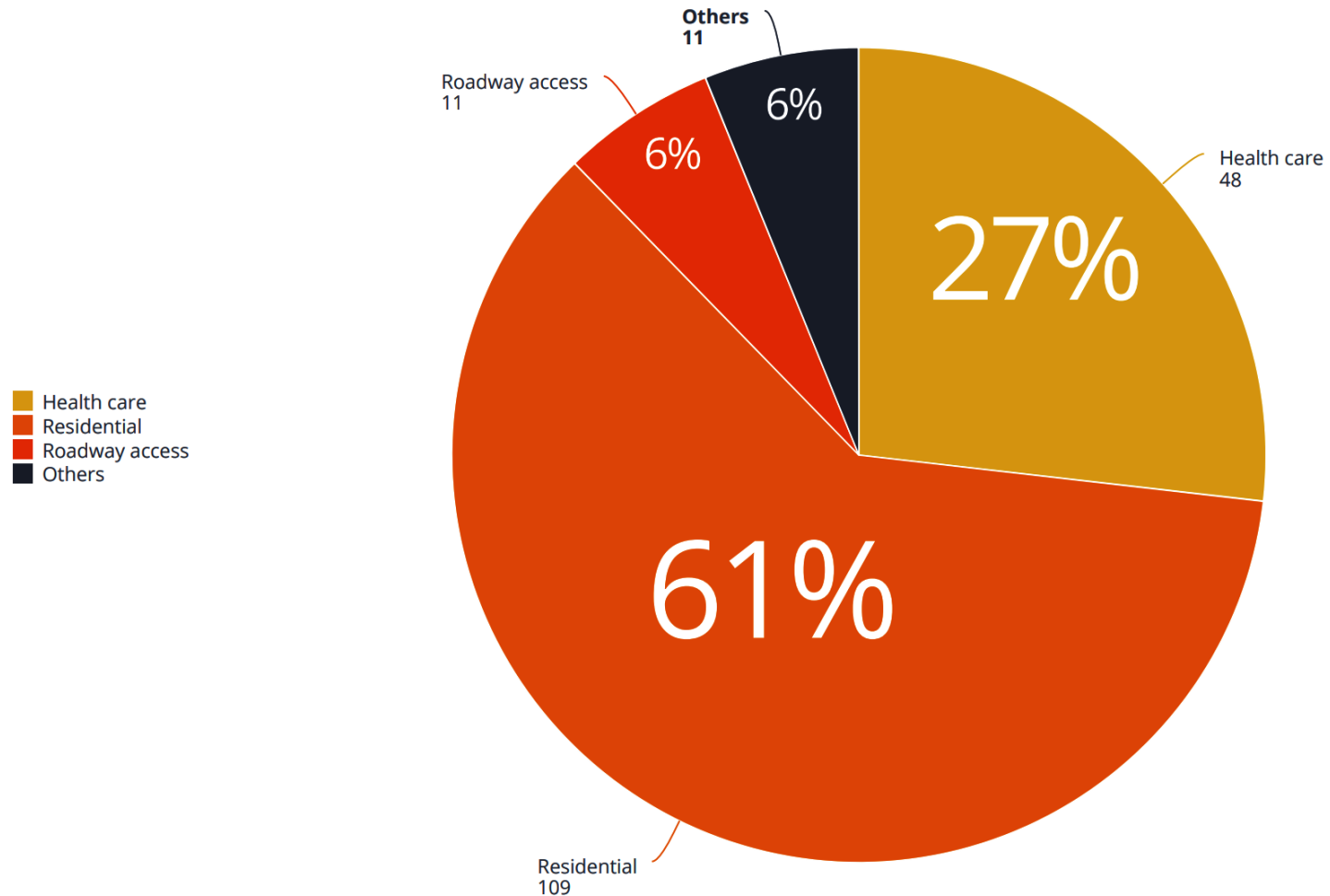
Incident Count By Unit – Last Month





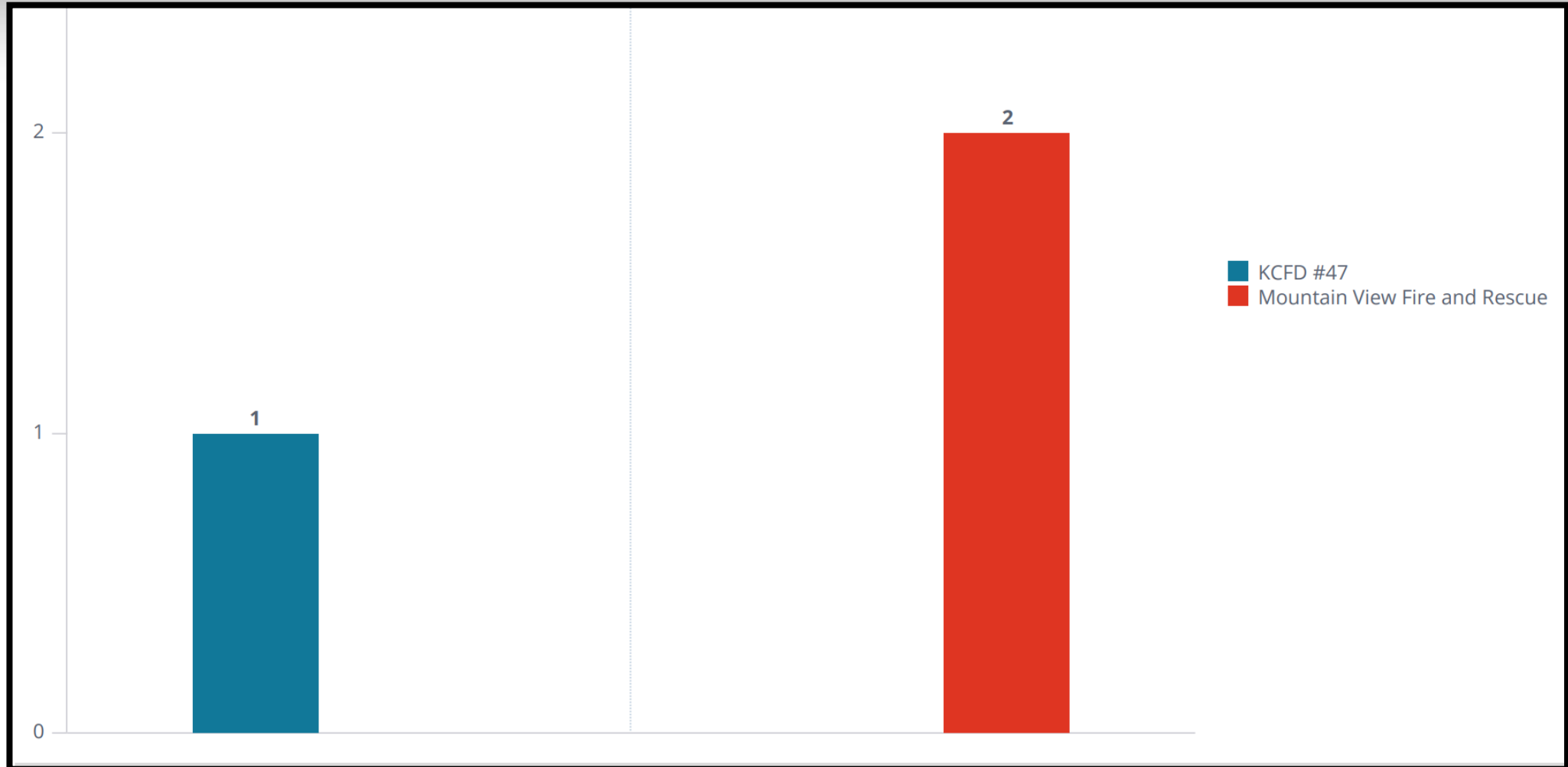
Top Three Incident Locations – Last Month

Incidents by Property Type (Top Three) - Last Month



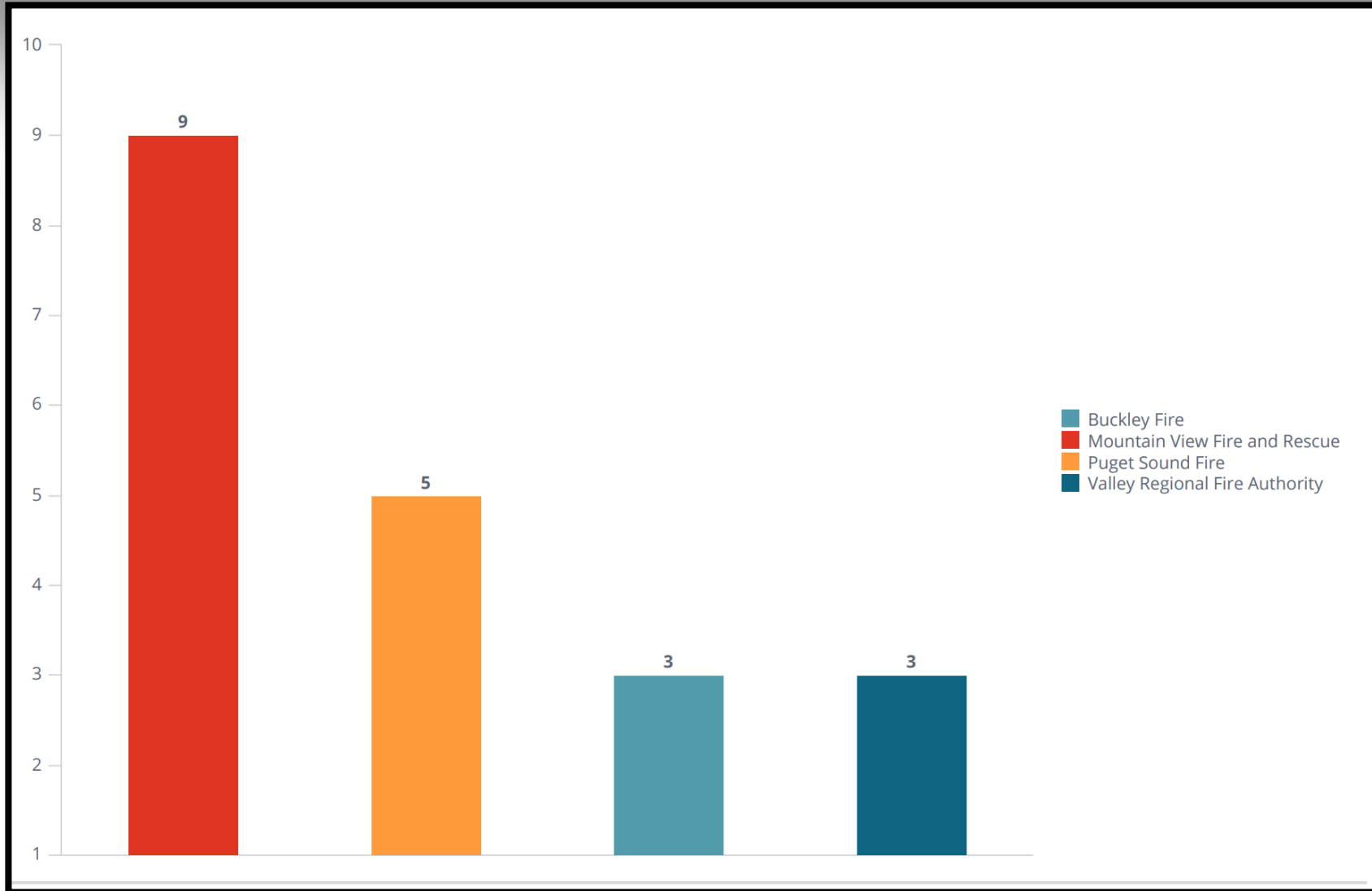


Auto Aid GIVEN – Last Month



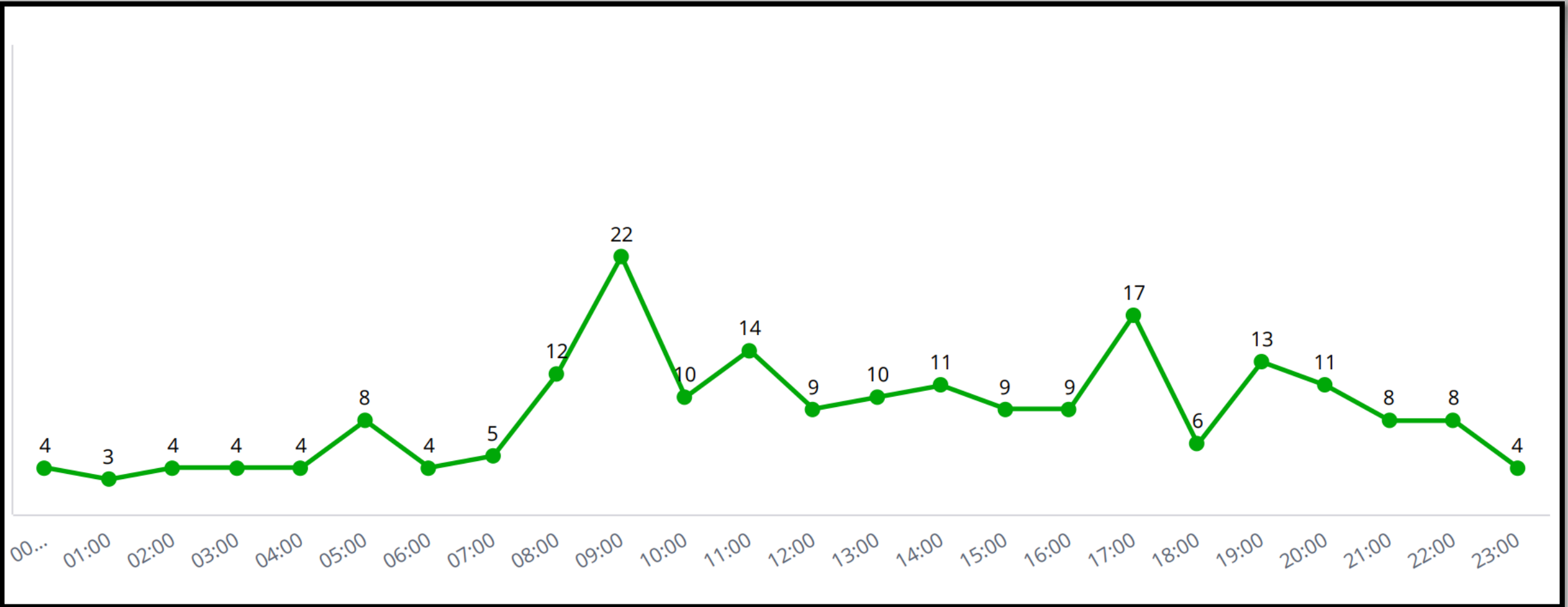


Auto Aid RECEIVED – Last Month



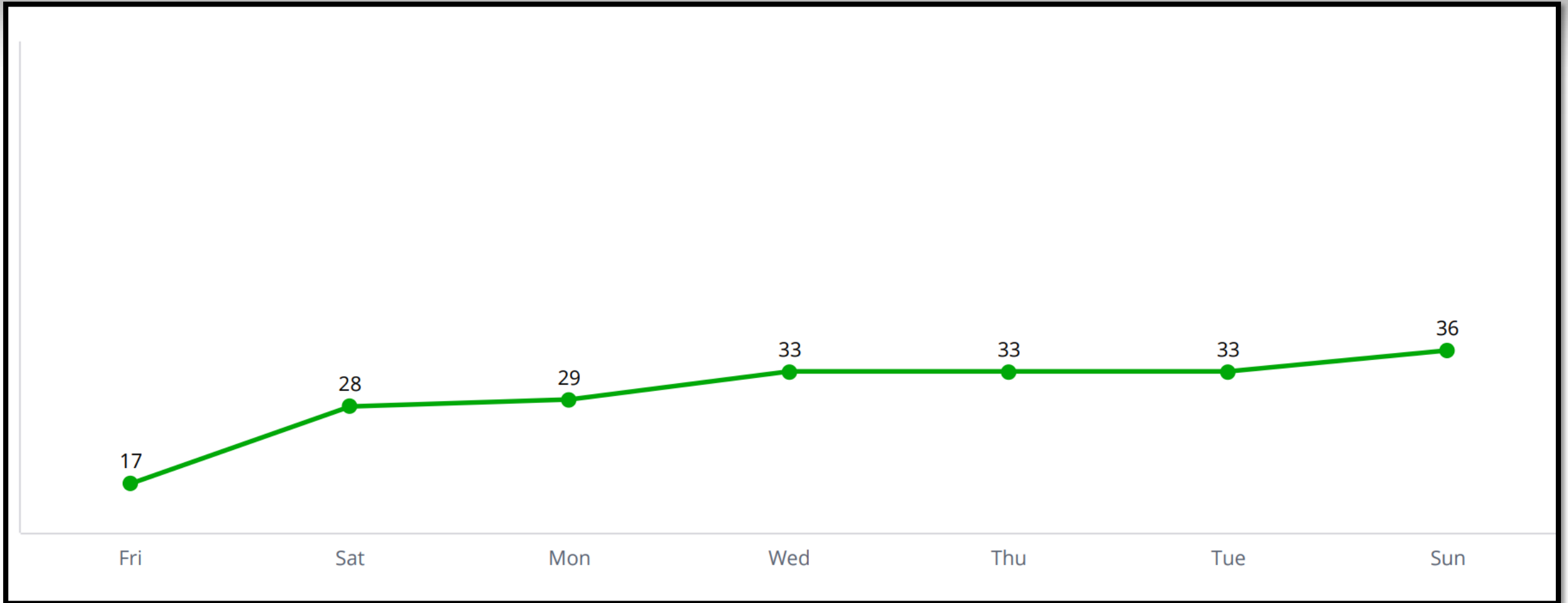


Incidents By Hour – Last Month





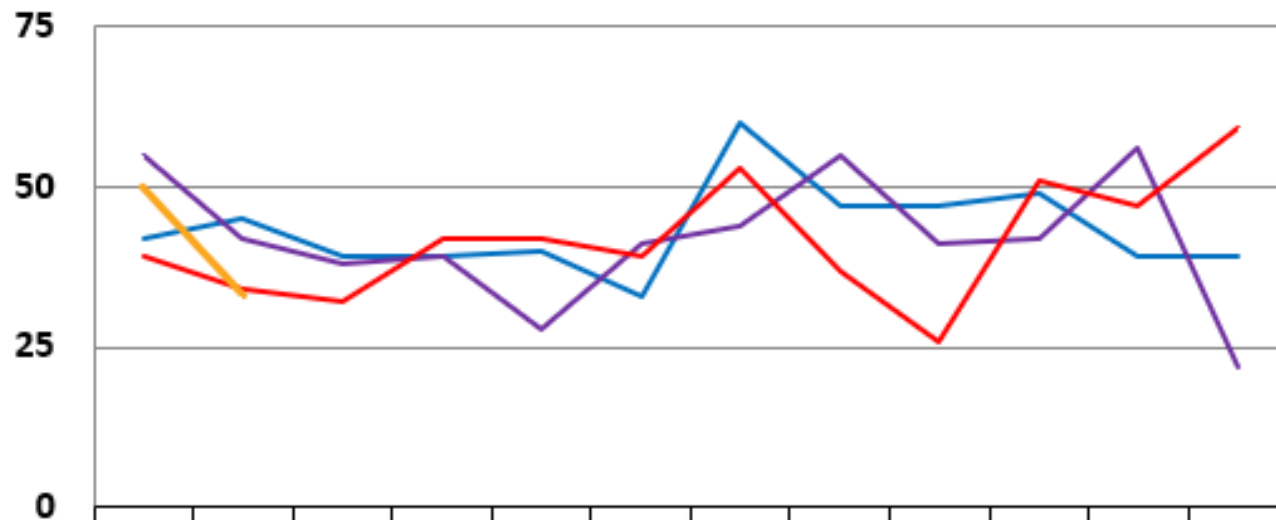
Incidents By Day – Last Month

Monthly Concurrent Calls Comparison



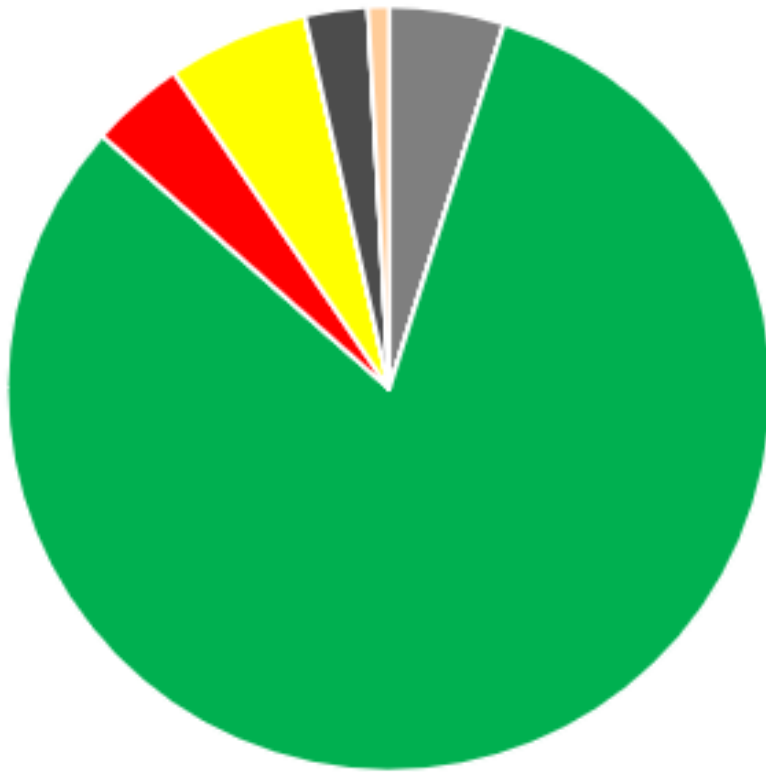
Concurrent Call Average

- 2026 Average/Month = 42



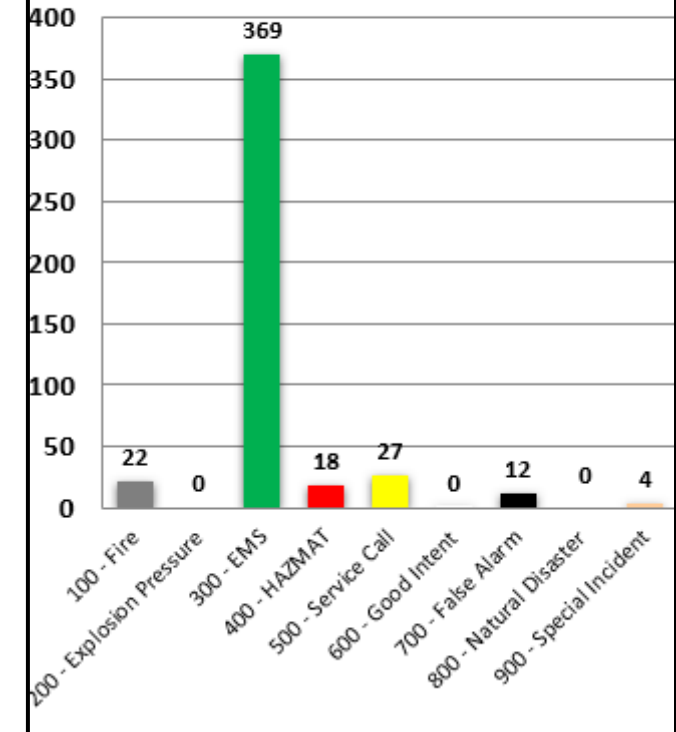
Incidents by Call Type – Year-to-Date

YTD Incident Types



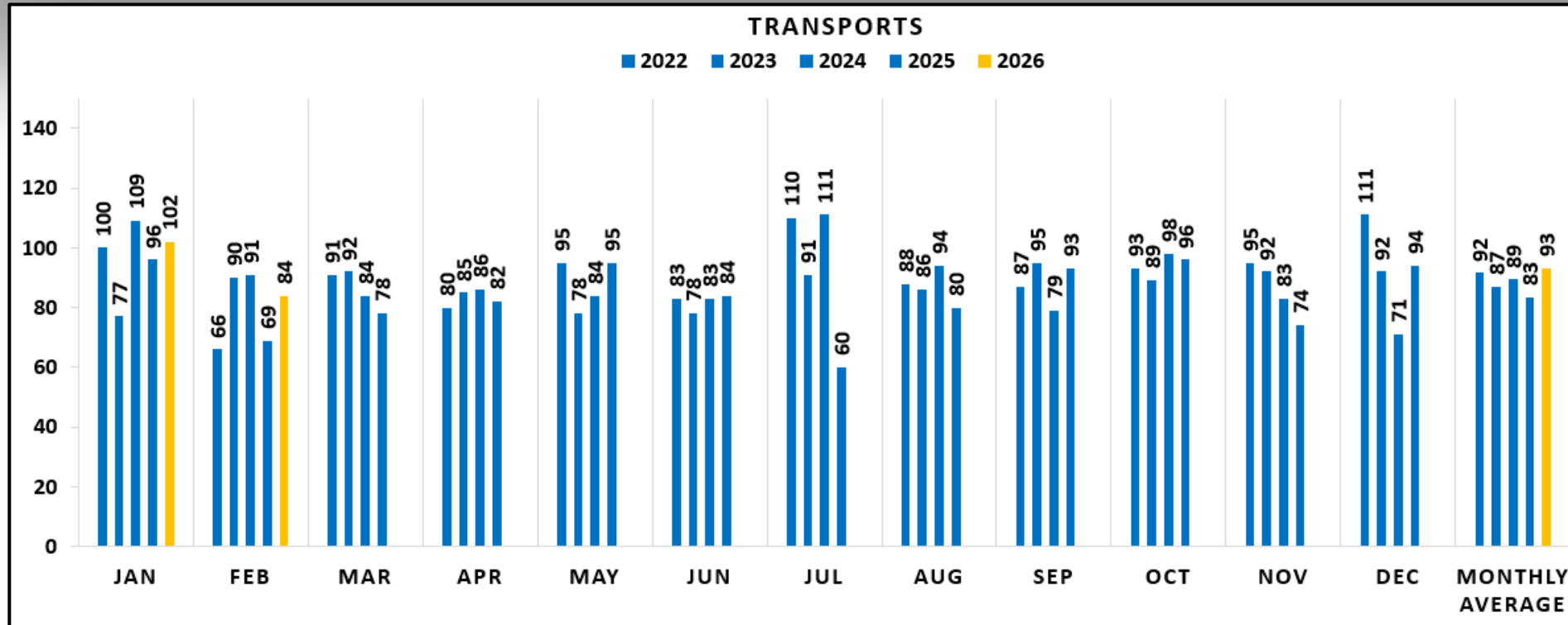
- 100 - Fire 4.9%
