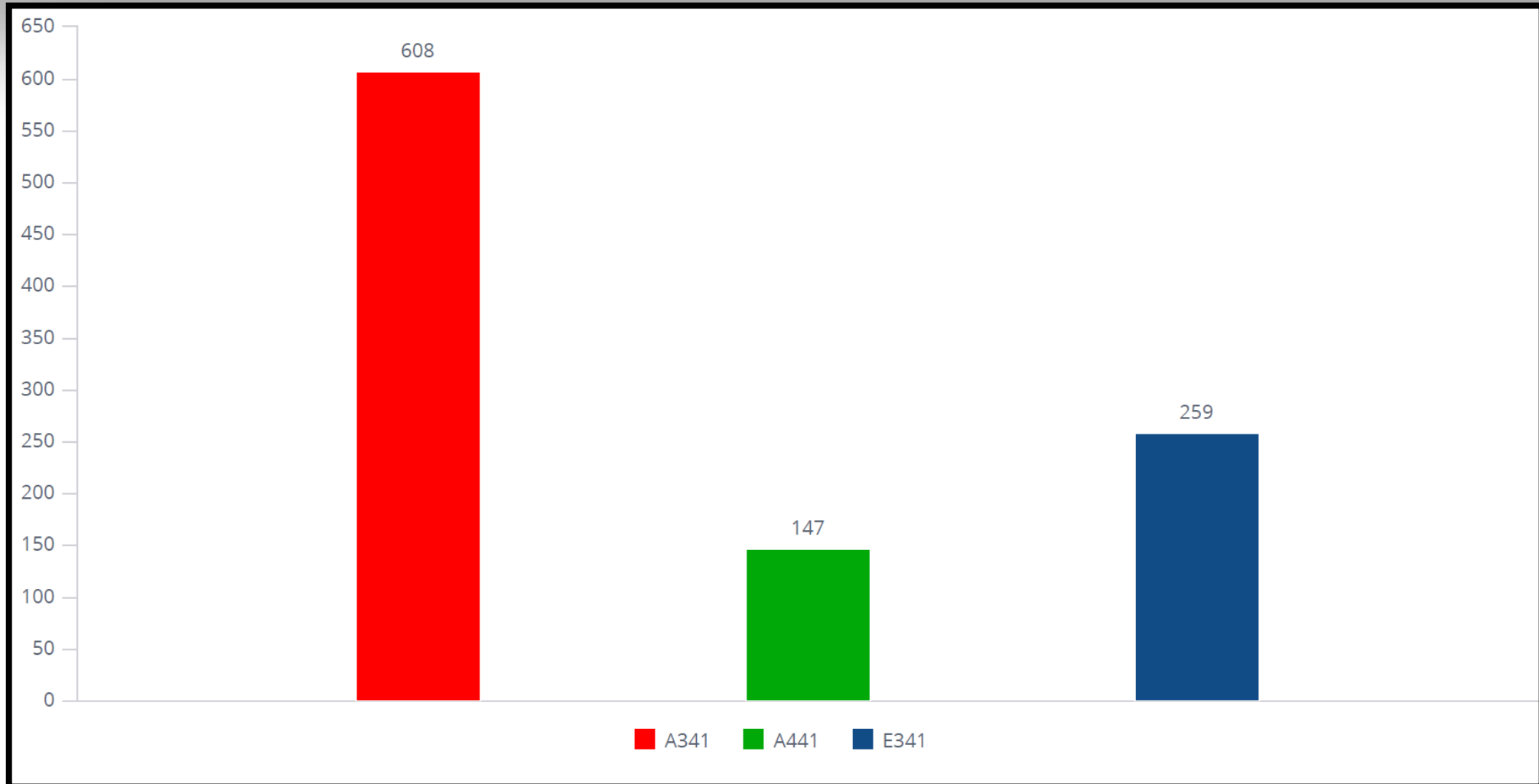

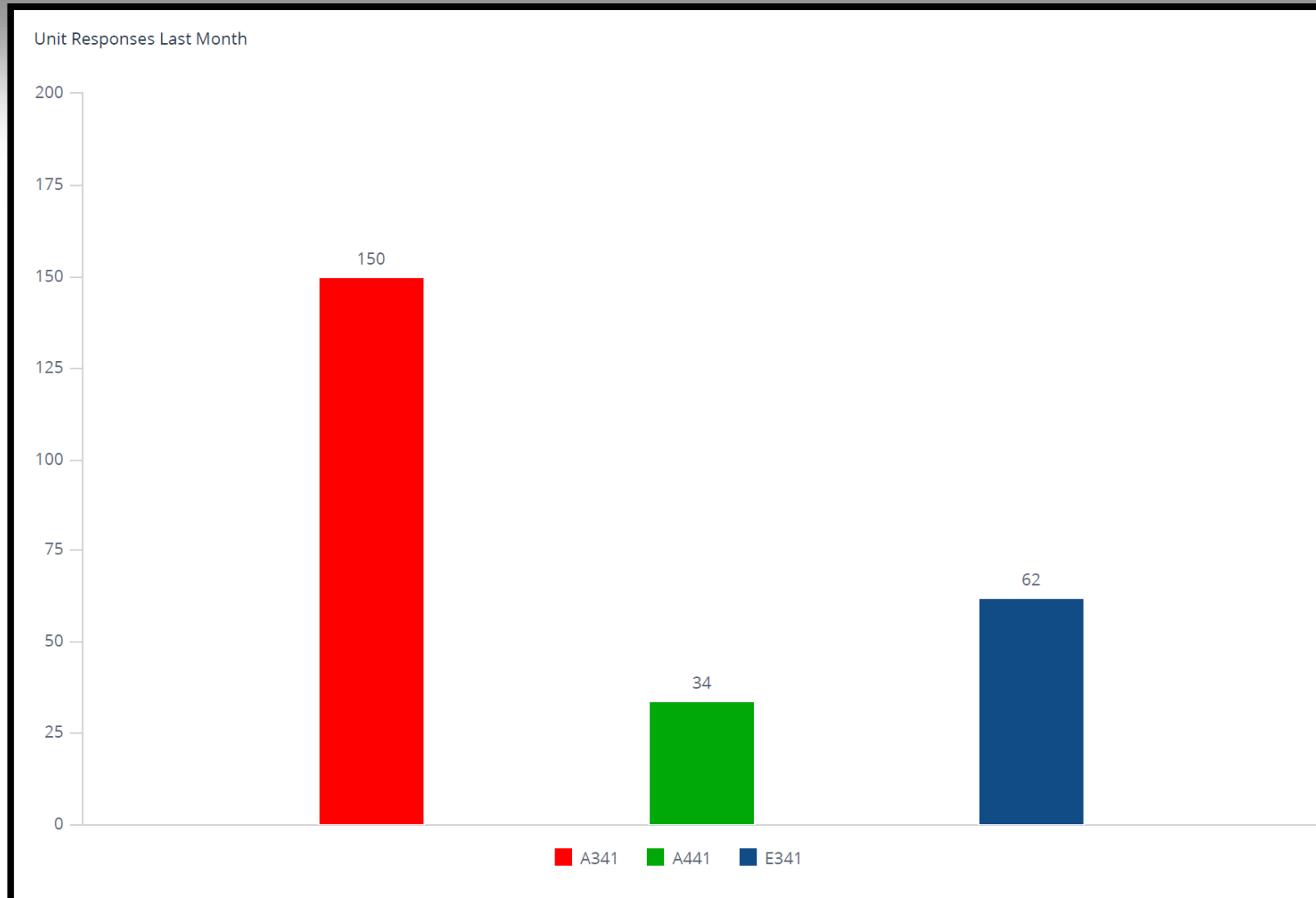


Responses By Unit – Year-to-Date



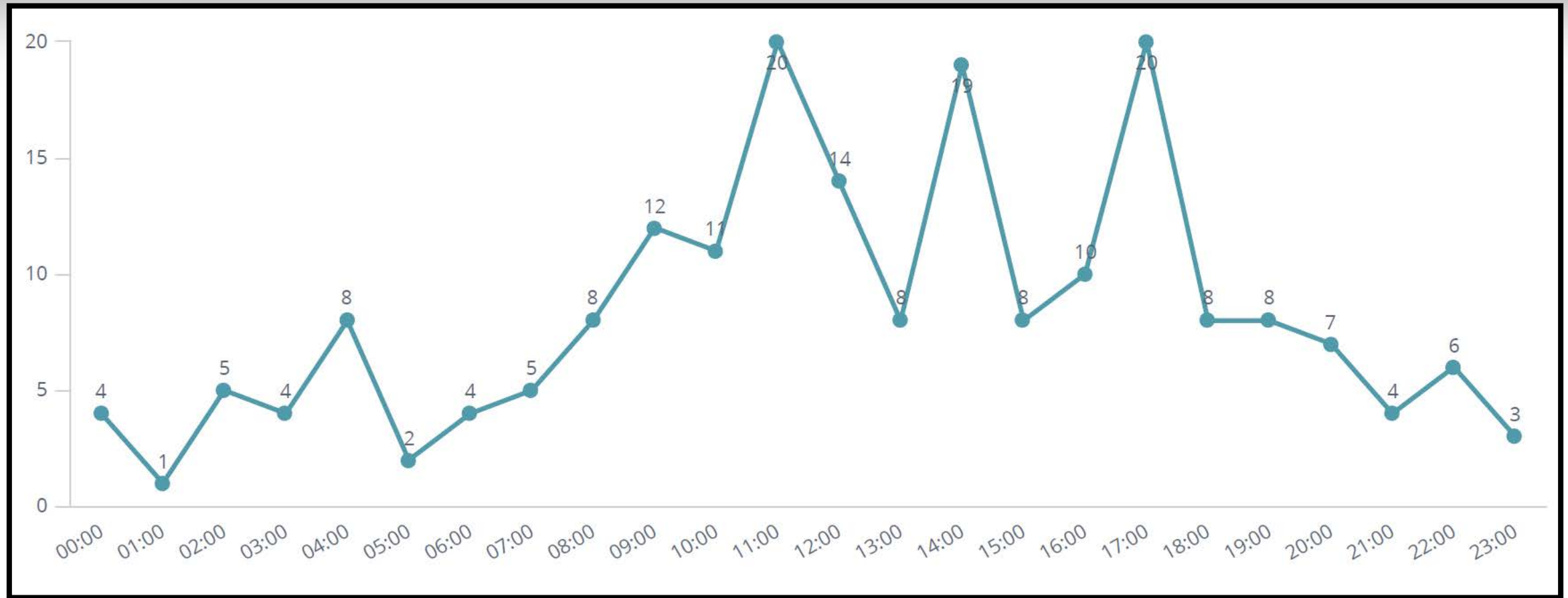


Responses By Unit – Last Month



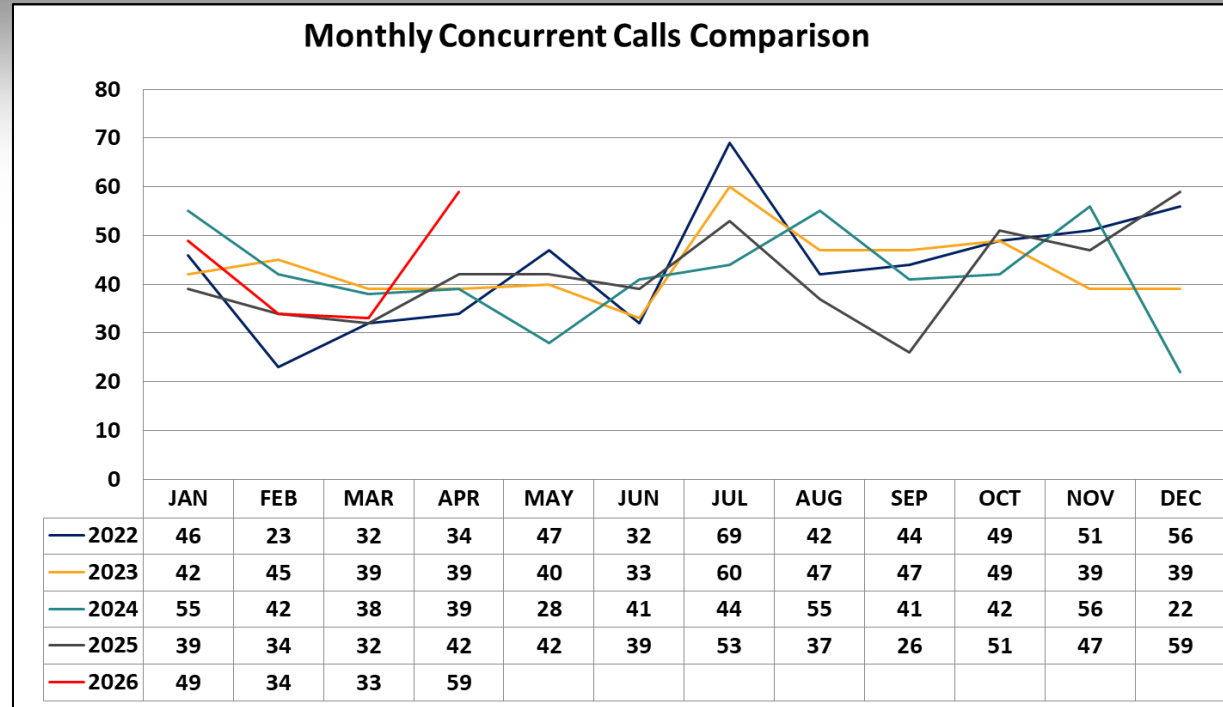


Incidents By Hour – Last Month





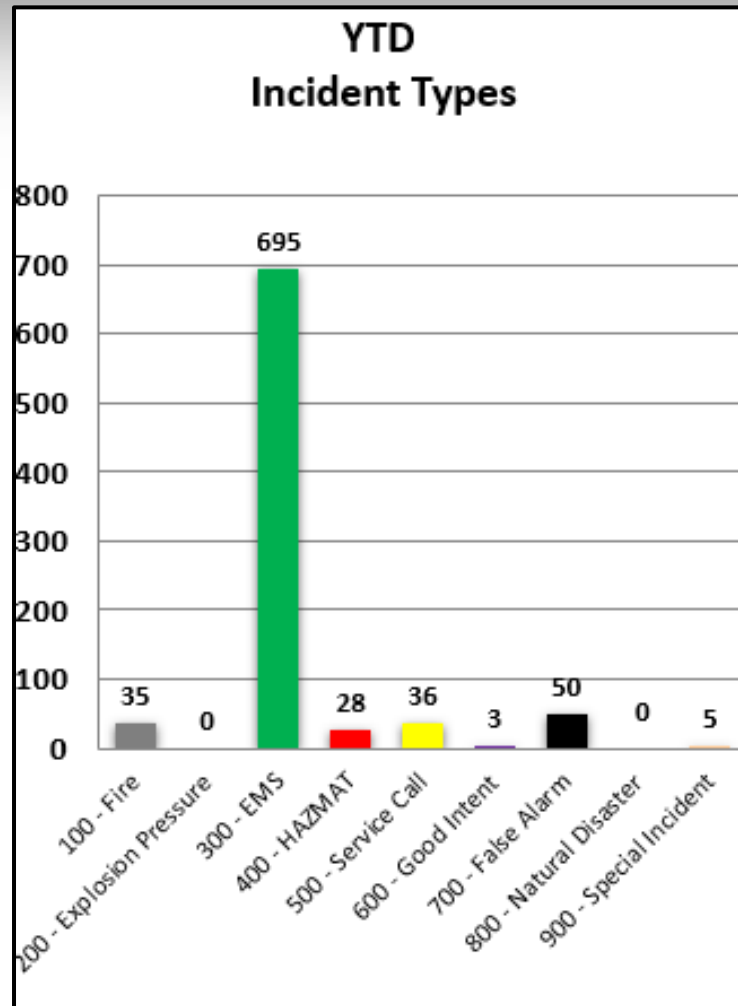
Concurrent Calls – Last Month

- With 3 of those instances being 3 concurrent calls.

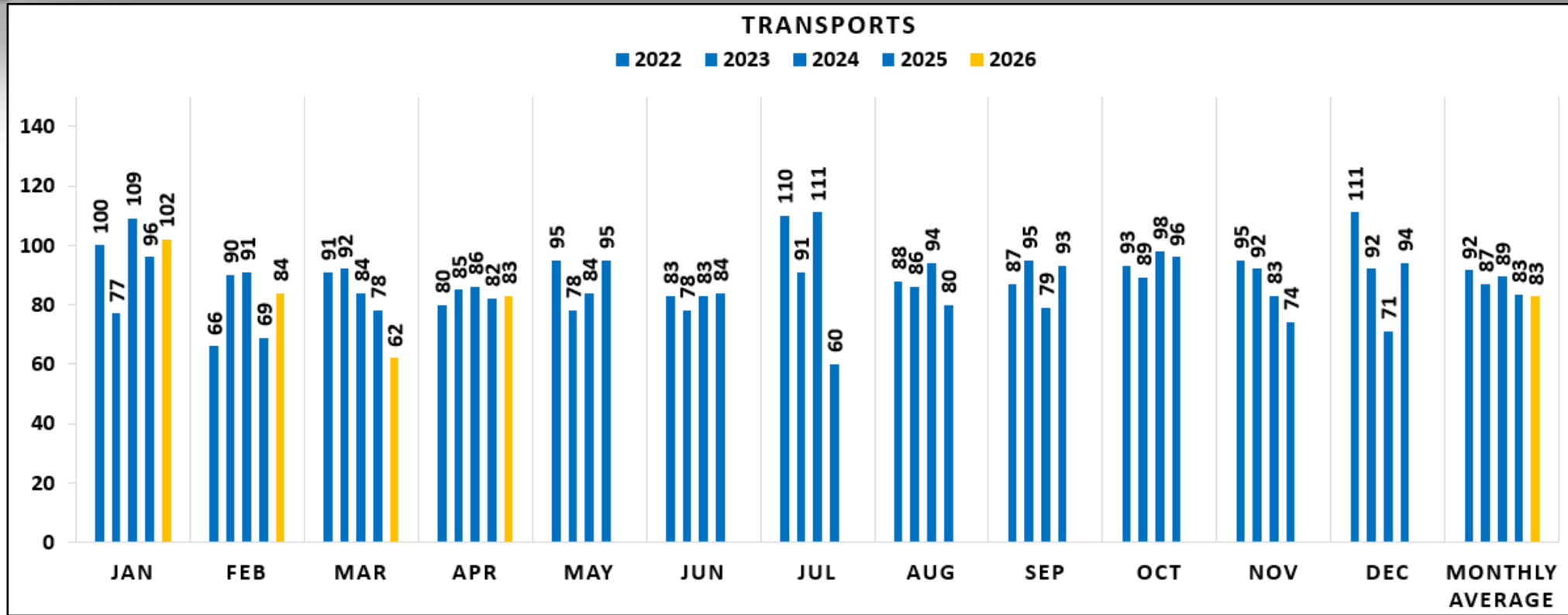


Incidents by Call Type – Year-to-Date





Patient Transport Comparison - Monthly

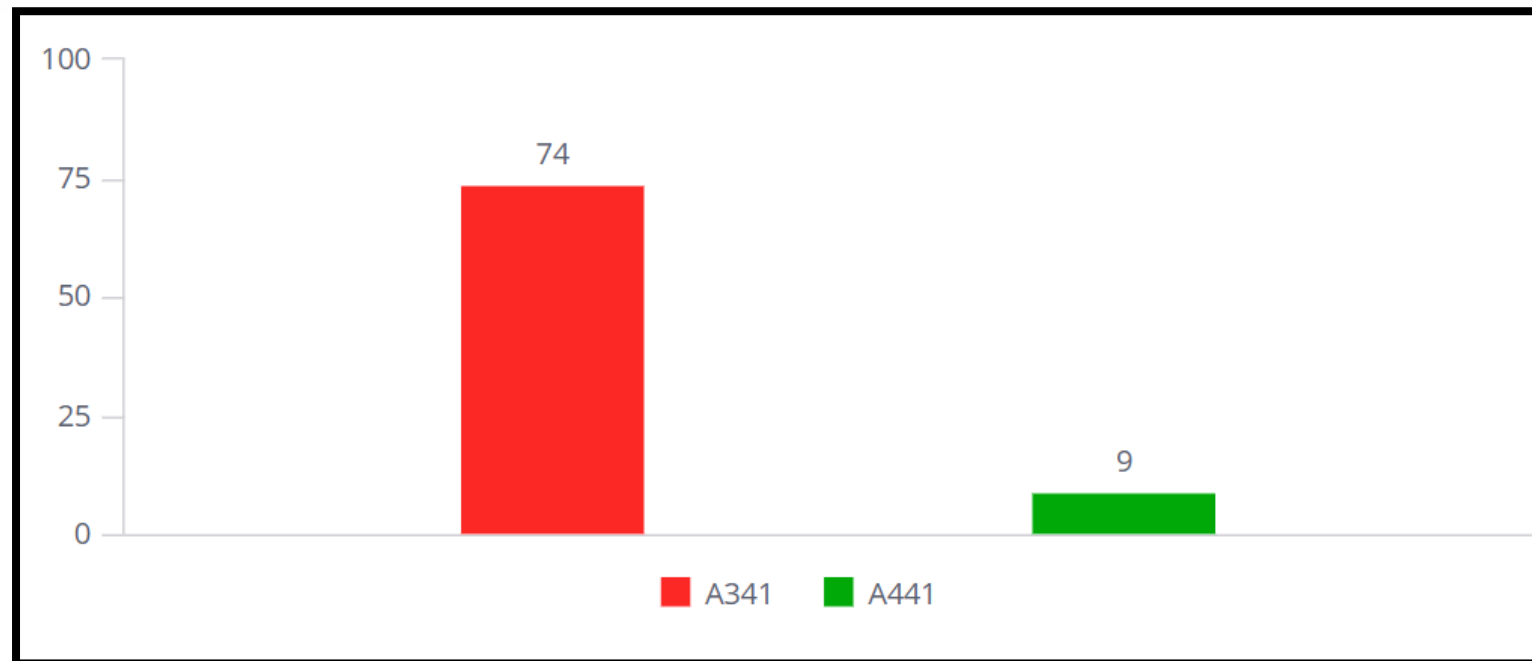


Transport Totals
