A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF ENUMCLAW FIRE DEPARTMENT, KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT #28, DECLARING APPARATUS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING TRANSFER.

WHEREAS, the Enumclaw Fire Department (King County Fire Protection District #28) owns a 2002 Ford F350 (Utility Pick-Up) apparatus No: 2800, VIN: 1FTSX31F82EA85488, WA License No. 58487C "Apparatus", and

WHEREAS, the Enumclaw Fire Department (King County Fire Protection District #28) owns a 2006 Ford E350 (North Star Aid Unit) apparatus No: 2803, VIN: 1FDWE35P46HA94683, WA License No. 42205D "Apparatus", and

WHEREAS, the Enumclaw Fire Department (King County Fire Protection District #28) owns a 2010 Ford E450 (North Star Aid Unit) apparatus No: 2804, VIN: 1FDXE4FP1ADA36135, WA License No. 99232C "Apparatus", and

WHEREAS, the Enumclaw Fire Department (King County Fire Protection District #28) owns a 1995 Wells Cargo Trailer (Utility) VIN: 1WC200G2XS4021124, WA License No. 79998D "Apparatus", and

WHEREAS, the Department no longer has a need for these Apparatus, and

WHEREAS, the Department has determined that the estimated fair market value of these Apparatus:

- 2002 Ford F350 is approximately \$5,500.00
- 2006 Ford E350 is approximately \$4,000.00
- 2010 Ford E450 is approximately \$4,000.00
- 1995 Wells Cargo Trailer is approximately \$100.00, and

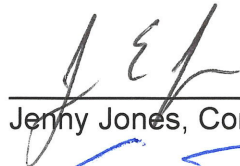
